

After being rescued from being left outside in the extreme cold with inadequate shelter, this boy was surrendered to our shelter. Poor Cameron needed immediate veterinary care for deep infected bite wounds to his face. He also was in need of groceries, treatment for multiple parasites, basic vaccines and neutering. Cameron was virtually catatonic when he arrived, and so he also desperately needled TLC. Cameron was provided with needed veterinary and nursing care and lots of TLC. He was admitted to our shelter as a neonatal kitten at just days old. He was cold and hungry and without his mother. He was immediately warmed and placed in foster care. Archie was provided with round the clock feedings of KMR, medical assessment, soft blankets, a warming disc, parasite control and lots of love. Despite the best of human care, neonatal kittens without their feline mother often do not survive. We are happy to share that Archie is now a playful 7 week-old kitten who eats on his own. He has been given initial vaccinations and was recently introduced to his new best friend (Eliza, another orphan kitten). Archie and Eliza are almost ready for adoption.



In 2019, we have been inundated rescuing and caring for hundreds of animals from multiple emergencies. Many were from animal cruelty cases and were sick or injured requiring immediate veterinary care. Many had little socialization and needed extra time and patience to rehabilitate them for adoption. We are currently at max capacity and our resources are fully stretched with providing care for ~100 cats and kittens, ~20 dogs, 9 horses, 2 minis. This does not include 11 pigs, 8 fowl, etc. from a recent law enforcement case.

Expenses for cleaning, food and medical supplies (like vaccines, parasite control, antibiotics, pain medicine, etc.) veterinary care and added staff time for daily animal care have skyrocketed.
