## REFLECTION

### Third Sunday of Easter

#### Let the Children Come Unto Me ...

As we move through the Easter season as a parish community, we also are spending these sacred days preparing many beautiful opportunities for our young people to encounter the Risen Lord in both Word and Sacrament. With both First Communion and Confirmation on the horizon, I humbly ask that you hold our youth preparing for these sacraments in your prayers, asking God to open their hearts and lives to all the graces and blessings He longs to offer them.

In a special way, I want to thank those parents (and grandparents) who make every effort to ensure that their children are properly educated in the Catholic faith and are present at our Sunday Liturgy. As a former teen-ager myself, I know that my parents didn't always have the easiest of journeys getting my brother and I to attend Sunday Mass. Looking back on that time in my life, I am grateful that they didn't make our religious upbringing an option but a way to learn responsibility, sacrifice and, ultimately, the honor that is due to God.

To that end, Immaculate Conception parish and St. Jude mission are striving in new and exciting ways to meet families where they are and walk with them in the faith formation of their children. Our *Academy of Faith Summer program* – a one-week intensive learning experience during the last week of June – allows *in-person* religious education for students in Grades 1 through 8. Tied into this program are events scheduled throughout the academic year (known as Academy Events) where families can come together at least 5 times from September through April in order to enhance their knowledge and love of Christ, His Church and our beautiful traditions. It has been a real blessing for me to see parents and children together at Stations of the Cross, Eucharistic Adoration and Paschal Candle-making activities (to name but a few).

Understandably, not every child is able to attend the Summer Academy, so know that there is also an option for a Fall Catechesis program in which students work with an on-line program from home (monitored by parents and our ICC team) and join us for the same in-person Academy Events scheduled throughout the year. As numbers indicate that most families prefer the Summer Academy, there will not be in-person Wednesday classes in 2026-2027, except for middle-school students as part of our Edge program.

Finally, there are always exciting opportunities as part of our LifeTeen program to engage our high school students with both formation and a chance to simply hang-out, have fun and share the faith journey together. These opportunities happen on Sunday nights throughout the year in our newly-renovated Youth Room dedicated just for our parish teens.

Many thanks to Vickie Eichler, our coordinator of Faith Formation, and her incredible team of volunteers for the time, energy and love they offer to our children each week. So many good things are happening here at our parish – spread the word (and the Word!) and sign-up today for our Academy and youth programs. We can't be a fully-alive Church without our young people (and our extraordinary volunteers)!

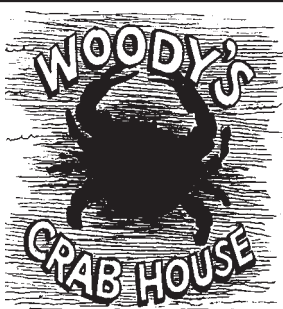

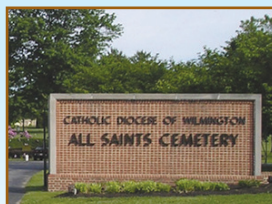
