#### C'mon Eileen ...

Everyone has that one friend who comes immediately to mind whenever a certain date appears on the calendar. For me, come early November, it's Eileen, the person who could always be counted on for a prayer that addressed needs which most people would consider unworthy of God's time and attention.

Not Eileen, though. At the mall during the holiday season, there was always this prayer: "Hail Mary, full of grace, help me find a parking space." Eileen was sincere in that ask, and whenever I was with her, she always found a great spot near the entrance. For her single female friends, Eileen taught them to pray throughout the day: "St. Ann, St. Ann, find me a man." (It often seemed to work.)

But then there was this, my favorite Eileen prayer: "Mother Cabrini, fix my machine-y." Whether it was a malfunctioning laptop or a car that would sputter at stoplights, Eileen gave a prayerful shout-out to America's first canonized saint. Amazingly, the prayer usually seemed to be answered almost immediately.

And why wouldn't it? St. Frances Xavier Cabrini, whose feast day we celebrate on Thursday, November 13, was one tough nun who got things done. Wanting to be a missionary to Asia, she was instead sent in 1889 to minister to the early Italian immigrants settling in New York, Philadelphia, Chicago and Denver. Back-and-forth she sailed from Italy in order to assist those most in need, never allowing her fear of water and sailing stop her from doing God's will. With great confidence in Christ's love, Mother would always plow ahead: starting schools and hospitals, finding proper housing for those experiencing poverty, and caring for the hungry and the sick from coast to coast.

It is said that Mother Cabrini only took "no" for an answer when it came from the Lord. May we be so bold in our own journeys of faith, and turn to Mother when we also need to fix a troublesome "machine-y" in our life.

After all, it always worked for Eileen!

### Readings for Next Week: Thirty-Third Sunday in Ordinary Time

#### First Reading: Malachi 3:19-20a

The prophet Malachi warned that the time would come when all the evil people would be punished. He then speaks of the arrival of "the sun of justice, with its healing rays," believed by most to mean Jesus.

#### Second Reading: 2 Thessalonians 3:7-12

Some of the Thessalonians claimed Christ's return was imminent, so they stopped working and asked others for food. Paul describes his willingness to work, so that he would not impose on others. He encourages them to follow his example and earn their own living.

#### Gospel: Luke 21:5-19

Jesus warns of the persecution all Christians will face because of him, and how some will even be put to death. Yet he says they will not be harmed because "by patient endurance you will save your lives." If Jesus' followers are loyal, they will be resurrected, and their suffering will end.




