## REFLECTION

Fifth Sunday in Lent

### It's Not Too Late...

A parishioner stopped me the other day and asked a question I haven't been asked before quite so directly: "How's your Lent going? It gave me pause. How *has* this season been for me?"

How's *your* Lent been?

Has it been a season of grace and an invitation to spend more dedicated time with the Lord in prayer? Have you and I found ways to give of our time, talent and treasure in order to help make Christ's Kingdom present in the world around us?

If these past weeks haven't been quite the Lent we imagined on Ash Wednesday, have no fear. There are still many beautiful ways to spend these final weeks preparing our hearts for the celebration of the Paschal Mystery of Christ.

Some suggestions:

- Add a few minutes of quiet or reflective prayer at the start or end of your day. Even five minutes of time with God opens us up to His Mercy in ways that will change our lives.
- Make an effort to attend the Sacrament of Reconciliation, allowing Christ to heal the wounds of sin that keep us chained to anger, sadness and fear. **(Reconciliation Monday will be held at every parish in the diocese on Monday, March 30 from 3 to 8 p.m.)**
- Spend a little extra time with Scripture during the week. There are many great Catholic podcasts and other resources that break open the Word, including one that we produce here at Immaculate Conception. (You can find it on our YouTube page and on a link through Flocknotes)
- Attend Stations of the Cross together as a family. It's a beautiful way to spend a half-hour reflecting on the love of Christ for us as we journey with Him to Calvary.
- Decide to offer a little sacrifice or extra prayer each of these remaining days of Lent for a particular person or intention. (Example: Monday – a decade of the Rosary for peace in Iran; Tuesday – no sweets as an offering for the souls on purgatory; etc.)
- Attend a daily Mass (in addition to Sunday) and receive our Lord in the Eucharist. Watch how His Presence will grace your day and week.
- Drop off a meal to a homebound neighbor or contribute to our Outreach program.
- Fast one day these remaining weeks of Lent from social media scrolling. You'd be surprised to see how one's anxiety-level drops as a result of the sacrifice.

Ultimately, as we journey together toward Easter, never forget how much God's merciful Love longs to lead us into deeper relationship with both God Himself and one another. We still have some good Lent time ahead – let's not miss the chance to grow in holiness!

**Readings for Next Week:  
Palm Sunday of the Passion of the Lord**

**First Reading: Isaiah 50:4-7**

In a tone of quiet sadness, Isaiah describes the buffets and insults given to the Suffering Servant. The passage ends on a note of hope.

**Second Reading: Philippians 2:6-11**

In exultant tones, Paul tells the Philippians to rejoice because Christ became man, died on the cross, rose from the dead, and sits triumphantly at the right hand of the Father.

**Gospel: Matthew 26:14—27:66**

This is the solemn narrative of the passion and death of our Lord Jesus Christ. Matthew recounts the treachery and betrayal of Judas and then describes the events of the Last Supper, culminating in the institution of the Eucharist. Jesus endures the Agony in the Garden; he is then brought before Caiaphas and Pilate and condemned to death. After His resurrection, the centurions shouted, "Clearly this was the Son of God!"

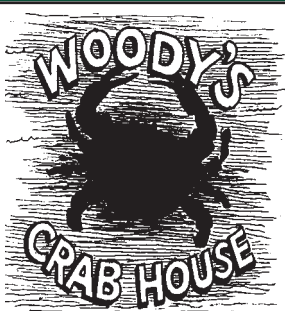

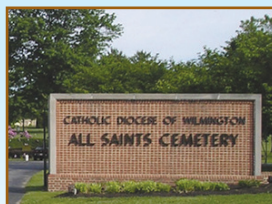

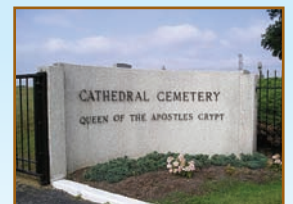
