## REFLECTION

Divine Mercy Sunday

### Mercy Hospital...

I was visiting a friend in a Philadelphia-area hospital on Easter Monday. She suffered a stroke on Good Friday, but thankfully was showing some real progress by the time I anointed her four days later. She was hopeful and determined to move forward, and that in and of itself is the message of Easter discipleship – trusting God while living in the shadow of the Cross.

As I was leaving her room, one of the nurses at the station near the elevator called after me: “Father, could I trouble you for a minute?”

As it turns out, there was an elderly patient two floors down who wanted nothing more than to see a priest at Easter. She has no family except a brother living in Connecticut, and he was not able to travel to see her this holiday.

When I walked into the third-floor room bringing Eucharist, the woman (whose name is Julia, by the way) turned from the window, her eyes bright with wonder: “Jesus *does* answer my prayers,” she cried, and then she took my hand and held it to her cheek.

We talked for a while that afternoon, and although her thoughts were often jumbled, it was clear to me that her 86-years were a beautiful tapestry in which the thread of her Catholicism held it all together. She loved her parish family, and that love was a true witness to me of what we are all called to be: hidden saints who leaven the world with Christ’s mercy, often in very simple ways in our own community.

“Father, I am ready to go Home,” she said to me at one point in the conversation, and I knew she wasn’t speaking of her home back in South Jersey. “But I will stay here as long as He needs me; I know God’s using my suffering to help others in theirs.”

Indeed, the Lord uses everything we offer to Him. Julia reminded me of that. How blessed I was on Easter Monday morning to encounter another hidden saint of Divine Mercy on the third floor of a Philadelphia hospital.

Third Sunday of Easter**

**First Reading: Acts 2:14, 22-33**

After the Holy Spirit descends upon the apostles, Peter preaches with great enthusiasm to both Jews and Christians. He recalls for them in vivid terms the miracles and wonders that Jesus performed.

**Second Reading: 1 Peter 1:17-21**

Peter makes reference to the Passover, when the Jews escaped from Egypt because the blood of the paschal lamb was shed. Now they are being saved from sin by the blood of Christ, the Lamb of the New Testament.

**Gospel: Luke 24:13-35**

Jesus reveals Himself to two disciples on the way to Emmaus. After explaining to them the passages in Scripture which referred to Him, Christ "took bread, broke it, and distributed it to them." Then they recognized Christ and their "hearts burned within them."

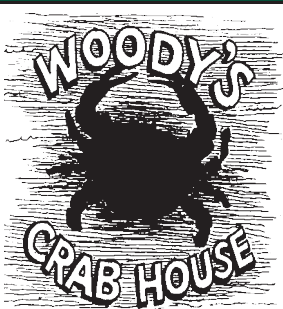

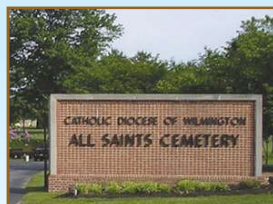
