**Shining Light**

July 20<sup>th</sup> will always hold a place in my heart: it was the day I buried a baby girl who lived 18 days outside her mother's womb, all of them in a hospital. Until she was born, there was never any indication that she would leave this world so soon.

Understandably, the funeral was so very hard for two parents still in their 20s, being asked to walk Calvary long before any mother or father should have to do so. But they did. In love for their little one and each other, they gave all.

I witnessed the self-emptying spousal and parental love from cradle to graveside, and it is a testament to the grace and strength God offers a couple through the Sacrament of Marriage. These newlyweds and grieving parents leaned on each other as they sought to embrace the heartbreaking goodbye.

As they stood beside her tiny casket that morning, they reminded me that when I baptized their daughter in the hospital, the name they chose for her means "Shining Light." I couldn't think of a more beautiful name, for that is who she is and who she will continue to be for all who knew this family's story.

Quite profoundly, as we made our way to the cemetery, a firetruck with its lights ablaze led the way for this little, tiny soul. What struck me so deeply was the number of cars that pulled over to allow the procession to pass with dignity. They did not know the baby whose remains were following the fire truck; they had no idea of the shortness of her life or the deep sadness of the mourners who followed behind the hearse.

Unknowingly, the countless motorists' simple gesture of respect paid witness to this one eternal truth: every life matters. Every life makes a difference, even a life of 18 days.

One brief "Shining Light" here on Earth has reflected the Light of Love Whom we call Our Father. In this little one's memory and through her intercession, may we spend our lives – no matter how long we have – helping others shine the beauty of their giftedness, too.

## Readings for Next Week: Seventeenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

### First Reading: Genesis 18:20-32

Abraham pleads with the Lord, who planned to destroy Sodom and Gomorrah because of the evil and sin in those cities. Abraham asks him if he would spare the city if fifty, forty, thirty, twenty or even only ten innocent people were found there. God says that he would spare the cities even for the sake of only ten.

### Second Reading: Colossians 2:12-14

Paul explains to the Colossians that through baptism, they are raised to life with Christ because they believed in the power of the God who raised him from the dead. Even though they once lived in sin, their sins have been pardoned through Jesus.

### Gospel: Luke 11:1-13

Jesus' disciples asked him how they should pray. He gave them some phrases similar to those now used in the Lord's prayer. Jesus also reminds the disciples how even men with sins are able to give good things to their children, and explains how much more the heavenly Father wants to give to us.

## FAITH FORMATION

### Primary Faith Formation:

#### Academy of Faith (Summer of 2025 Program):

All Religious Education students that attended the Summer Academy of Faith Program will need to attend five (5) Academy Card Events or Edge Events this year.

These events will be posted by the end of July as well as the registration link.

Academy Cards (for Grades K - 5): In August each child will be given an Academy Card which includes a list of various activities, events, and community opportunities from which to choose. You MUST complete at least five (5) events. The Academy Card options run from the end of September through the middle of April. These are family events and at least one parent/guardian must attend with their child.

Edge Events (for Grades 6 - 8): This program runs once a month from mid-September through the beginning of April. Youth in these grades must complete five (5) Edge Events. Edge is Catholic middle school youth ministry that helps young people with life's most challenging years. It is designed to foster faith formation, community, and personal encounters with Jesus; providing a safe, fun, and engaging environment for middle schoolers to explore their faith, ask questions, and grow in their relationship with Christ.

#### Religious Education Class:

Traditional Wednesday Evening Class will now be called "Family Home School Program". This is a hybrid program combining classroom catechesis and at-home activities. It will run from mid-September to beginning of April. Registration for this program will open at the end of July 2025.

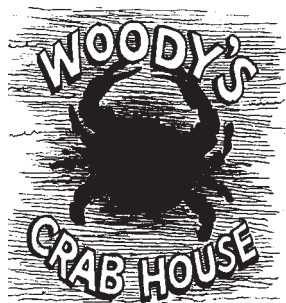

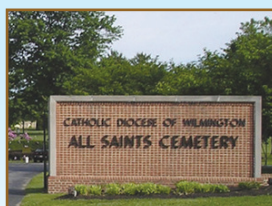

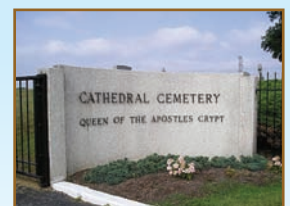
