

Having stable housing is a crucial aspect of a family's overall stability. That's why United Way of the Piedmont's Homeless Prevention Fund exists—to help families move out of crisis and keep moving towards long-term self-sufficiency.

THE CHALLENGE

1 in 4 individuals in our community can't afford their basic needs—things like food, rent, or transportation to work. For a family that has difficulty meeting day-to-day needs, an unexpected expense can mean that housing or utility bills become extremely difficult to pay.

When families get to the point of eviction or service cut-off, the compounded expenses are much higher than the family can pay, and they have an increased risk of becoming homeless.

HOW WE HELP

Community Resource Coordinators

Through intensive case management, our Community Resource Coordinators address the family's immediate crisis so they can work towards long-term stability.

Rent and Utilities Assistance

Through the Homeless Prevention Fund, rent and utility assistance can be provided to maintain the family's housing.

Security Deposit Assistance

Families struggling with homelessness often have difficulty securing housing because they are unable to pay the security deposit in addition to their first month's rent. The Homeless Prevention Fund can provide security deposit assistance to remove this barrier to becoming housed.
