Prohibited Conduct

To protect the integrity of this community, the following behaviors are not permitted on this page:

- Harassment, bullying, threats, or personal attacks directed at any individual or organization.
- Profanity, obscene language, or sexually explicit content.
- Misinformation, deliberately false claims, or misleading content.
- Spam, repetitive posts, or unsolicited commercial advertising.
- Posting private or personal information about others without their consent (“doxing”).
- Content that promotes illegal activity or endangers health and safety.
- Off-topic content unrelated to our mission or community.

Moderation & Enforcement

- Remove any comment, post, or content that violates this policy without prior notice.
- Hide or restrict comments that are off-topic or disruptive to constructive conversation.
- Issue a warning to users who violate this policy.
- Temporarily or permanently ban users who repeatedly or seriously violate this policy.
