WORD, Made Flesh

"We honor the three births of Our Lord at Christmas. The first is the eternal birth of the Son of God in the bosom of His Father. The second is His temporal birth in the little stable of Bethlehem. The third is His mystical birth in our hearts by means of Holy Communion and His grace."

"Consideration of His first birth should lead us to adore the Son of God on the throne of His glory in the endless reaches of eternity, where equal to the Father, He receives the adoration of the Angels and Seraphim. Consideration of His second birth should lead us to adore Him on the throne of poverty which is the throne of love. He hides His grandeur because He wants us to draw near to Him without fear."

"Thirdly, after having adored Him in Heaven, after having adored Him in the crib, we should adore Him present within us. I beseech you to cross your arms upon your heart where the Savior dwells and say to Him, 'I adore you in my heart. I adore you within me. You are as truly within me as You are in Heaven, as truly as You are in the crib, where you receive the adoration of the poor shepherds. You are truly within me. May all the powers of my soul, my thoughts, my sentiments, my affections come forth to adore you." (Louis Brisson, Cor ad Cor)

As we prepare once again to celebrate the solemnity of the Incarnation at Christmas, let us adore Him by giving birth to Jesus through our love for one another.



St. John Neumann Preschool offers half-day classes for children ages 2 ½ to 4 years old giving them an educational foundation rooted in Catholic teaching.




