- Ensuring all team members receive appropriate safety training and are accountable for safe work practices
- Supporting initiatives that promote both physical and psychological wellbeing
- Demonstrating leadership commitment to safety as a core part of service quality, operational performance and sustainability
- Managing operational priorities to ensure safety and wellbeing are never compromised
- Consulting and collaborating with workers, clients and stakeholders to share knowledge and continuously improve safety outcomes
