## Even More Live Music in 2026, Starting This Month

This year we're pulling out all the stops to give you more live music than ever.

We start straight away with the debut performance by a young band devoted to the music of The Cure.

Taking place on Saturday 17 January in the Acoustic Lounge, Curiosa will be pumping out all those great hits including Boys Don't Cry, Friday I'm in Love, Just Like Heaven, Pictures of You, Lovecats and more - plus deep cuts! Supporting Curiosa is a highly talented local young band called White Label, bringing you a fantastic selection of their own indie-rock songs.

Please do come along and show your support for these new acts. Admission is free. Please let us know you're coming so we can manage numbers.

The live music keeps on coming with The Highwasters and Sing-along-a-Nick in February and five gigs in March, starting off with Moonshine, a brand new group made up of 6 musicians from well-known bands coming together to play Southern US Rock classics. Our friend Steve Morano will provide support. Find out more on our What's On page. The following day we have Moonage Unplugged, a year on from their debut show here. The trio of Andrew, Paul and Ollie will be playing well-known and lesser known tracks from Bowie's vast collection in the intimate setting of the Acoustic Lounge.

On Wednesday 7th March we have the pleasure of hosting Chicago-based funky-blues quartet Electric Soul Company and then on Saturday 21st Pretty Green, a highly



impressive and energetic tribute to The Jam will be pumping out over 40 songs.

The following Saturday sees The Loungeroom Lizards here for the first time, dedicated to the masterful songs of Crowded House.

In April we welcome Rea-Loaded, a new band of professional musicians from the Midlands paying tribute to the late great Chris Rea.

Following Jewels and the Jacuzzi's return on Saturday 2 May, we open up the Rose Stage once more for no fewer than 15 outdoor concerts.

Our Gigs in the Garden season is truly magical and we look forward to welcoming both new bands (including tributes to Tina Turner, Spandau Ballet and Duran Duran, The Small Faces, Jamiroquai and Meat Loaf) and returning bands including Fleetwood Mad, Moonage, CODA, Supersonic Queen, the Trembling Wilburys and, last here in 2019, the brilliant 10-

piece tribute to Steely Dan: Stanley Dee).

Kicking off the Gigs in the Garden series is a special day raising funds for Blood Cancer UK. We have some excellent bands performing for free including Moonshine (Southern US Rock), The Incredible Spring Band (rock covers performed by a band of familiar faces!), the Ding Dong Daddios (top swing and jive quartet) and Moonage (Best Of Bowie). The day has been arranged as a memorial to Dave Robinson, a wonderful customer and a good friend to many, including members of all the bands performing.

Tickets are a £10 donation with all funds going to Blood Cancer UK. Tickets for all gigs are available now. Those paid in cash cost less than card and online purchases. All the details are on our What's On page. Food will be available to pre-order for every single gig.
