Live Music Intensifies with Summer Approaching

5 gigs this month

Spring is in the air and with it comes a whole host of top notch gigs leading up to our summer series of Gigs in the Garden.

The Acoustic Lounge is home to the following bands this month, so do come along and experience fantastic musicians performing some great music.

Friday 6 March: Moonshine supported by Steve Morano

Moonshine is a brand new 6-piece band bringing you Southern Rock classics from Lynyrd Skynyrd, the Allman Brothers, Georgia Satellites and many more. Support comes from the highly talented singer-songwriter Steve Morano. Tickets £10 (or £15 if you combine it with Moonage Unplugged on the following night).

Saturday 7 March: Moonage - Bowie Unplugged supported by White Label Unplugged

The return of the Moonage trio playing Bowie singles and album tracks unplugged, with support from White Label, the indie-pop band who played here in January, performing a selection of their original songs unplugged. Tickets £12 (or £15 if combined with Moonshine the previous night).

Wednesday 11 March: Electric Soul Company

From Chicago, this 4-piece stops here as part of their European tour performing funky, soulful blues songs, fronted by guitarists Breezy Rodio and Will Jacobs. Tickets £12 with a BOGOF offer available.

Saturday 21 March: The Jam tribute Pretty Green

This highly energetic trio will be pumping out every track recorded by The Jam. Tickets £12.

Saturday 28 March: Crowded House tribute The Loungeroom Lizards

This Oxfordshire band is devoted to the wonderful music of Crowded House. Tickets £12
