## **Demo 1: Viewing Saved Passwords**

What You Will Learn:

How to locate and view a saved password in the Passwords App

Step-by-Step Instructions:

- Find and open the Passwords app on your Home Screen
- 2. Unlock with Face ID or your passcode
- 3. Look for a website or app name you know (like Gmail, Amazon, Apple ID)
- 4. Tap the name to view your saved Username and Password (tapping on the black bubbles reveals your password)
- 5. Tap "Copy Password" if you need to use it elsewhere

## **Demo 2: Adding and Editing a Password**

What You Will Learn:
How to add a new password (and edit one)

Step-by-Step Instructions: Open the Passwords app

- Tap the + Add Password button
- 2. Type in the Website, Username, and Password For practice, use this info for test purposes:

Website: www.adidas.com

Username: icreativelearning@icloud.com

Password: Iloveicecream123!!

(Only the "I" before the word 'love' is CAPS)

- 3. Tap the checkmark top right (Done) to save
- 4. To change it later: tap the website name, then Edit

- 3. To see if you have any weak or repeated passwords, open Passwords again
- 4. Tap Security Recommendations
