Demo 1: Putting the Passwords App on your front Home Page of Apps

What You Will Learn:

Let's get the Passwords App onto Page 1 of your Apps so that it's easy to get to from now on!

Step-by-Step Instructions:

1. Locate the Passwords App 🔐



- 2. If you cannot find it:
- 3. Swipe down on the middle of any Home Screen
- 4. Start typing the word 'Passwords' until you see the icon in your search results
- 5. You can actually tap and hold on the icon, right from the search results, and drag it from there onto your page of icons
- 6. Drag the app from page to page by dragging it near the edge of a page until it's on page 1.

How to navigate the App

Step-by-Step Instructions: Open the Passwords app

- 1. Select the 'ALL' option
- 2. Peruse any saved passwords, and tap on the bubbles in the 'Password' field to reveal a password-note that you can easily copy it
- 3. Open WiFi and make note of all of those saved WiFi networks and their passwords!
- Click on the Security section and make note of any 'Compromised Passwords' that you need to change
- 5. Use the Search option at the bottom!

Demo 3: Playing with AutoFill

What You Will Learn:

How passwords can fill in automatically and how to see if any passwords need changing

Step-by-Step Instructions:

- 1. In the 'ALL' section make a note of a password that you know to be recent and that *MIGHT* work
- 2. Open Safari and go to that website
- Tap to log in your saved password will pop up. Look for the Passwords icon! Tap Use Password
- 4. If it does not work, now we know that you have to change that password and make sure to come back to that password to update it!
