- Facilitate basic Computer classes and teach adult participants;
- Participants are newcomers to Canada and have various first languages;
- Computer classes take place IN PERSON at 521 Bannatyne Avenue.

3. Skills Required:

- Teaching experience preferred;
- Strong knowledge/skills of Microsoft Office (Word, Excel and PowerPoint);
- Comfortable using technology including internet and ZOOM;
- Familiar with general computer usage;
- Interested in and enjoy working with newcomers;
- Comfortable working with people who speak various levels of English;
- Comfortable working with people from various cultural backgrounds;
- Have a passion to share skills and have a positive impact on the lives of others;
- Dependable and reliable.

4. Time Commitment:

- Available for at least one 2-hour session per week for three to six months.

- Police Record Check for Vulnerable Sector (by Winnipeg Police), will be reimbursed;
