Structure
Certified reforested wood (Eucalyptus Grandis and OSB panels), kiln-dried with controlled moisture.

Frame Assembly
Galvanized staples and special adhesive are used at all wood joints to ensure a strong, durable structure.

Foam
Foams certified to ISO 9001, manufactured without CFCs.

Comfort System
Foam.

Fixed – D-26 Soft / Hiper Flex D-26 foam covered with polyester fiber.

Backrests
Fixed – D-26 Soft / Hiper Flex D-26 foam covered with polyester fiber.

Arms
Fixed – Hiper Flex D-26 foam covered with polyester fiber.

Jequitibá wood – 12,2” height
