Dear MU Members,

Thank you to all the members who were able to attend our AGM/Council meeting on Saturday the 18th October, both in person, and on zoom. Thank you too, for apologies received, you were there in Spirit!.

Mrs Kerryn Lewis, Program Manager of PVAW (Prevention of Violence Against Women) gave us an insightful talk, into the beginnings of the Program in the Diocese, and also a detailed explanation of the process and timeline for translating PVAW training into the Karen Language. She also spoke of how it has been applied in other cultures. I have since heard from Kerryn. She thanked us for the opportunity to present on Saturday and said she had some really beneficial conversations after the meeting, making positive connections. PVAW is also considering work with the Dinka community.

All reports were received as documented within the AGM booklet, however, I would like to mention a few of the discussions. **Holding the Light Service** will be held on **Wednesday 3rd December at 5pm** in the Wesley Uniting Church. Guest Speaker will be Ms Sherele Moody, Australia's key femicide researcher, an award-winning journalist and media advocate for families impacted by femicide.

Whilst the positions in Executive Committee for Link Coordinator, Social Issues, and Intercessory Prayer are elected for 2025/26, the coordinators would like to stand down at the 2026 AGM. I ask for anyone who would be interested in taking on these roles, and become part of our Melbourne Council, to contact me for a fuller explanation of what is involved. You would be working side by side with the current coordinator to enable you to "learn the ropes/how things are done at the moment". We welcome your input in these important roles for MU.

Rosemary Hicks is the World Day of Prayer (WDP) MU representative. WDP has asked if we have more MU members who would like to take part in the Committee. This will not involve an "official" role. Please contact either Rosemary, or myself, if you would like more information.

## **Dates of MU Happenings around Melbourne:**


