# EASTERN EUROPE PILGRIMAGE TOUR

## 13 DAY TRAVEL ITINERARY

### DAY 1 MIAMI / PRAGUE

Head to the airport for your flight out of Miami to Frankfurt.

### DAY 2 PRAGUE

Arrive Prague and head to your hotel in Prague for dinner and overnight.

### DAY 3 PRAGUE

This morning's sightseeing begins with a walking tour of the Castle area, including the St. Vitus Cathedral, St. George Basilica, Loretto Church, Strahov Monastery and Wenceslaus Square. This afternoon you see the Old Town, St. Nicholas Church and the famous Astronomic Clock. Celebrate Mass at the Church of Our Lady of Victory and venerate the original statue of the Infant Jesus of Prague! Return to your hotel for dinner and overnight.

### DAY 4 KUTNA HORA / KRAKOW

After breakfast, board the bus and travel to Kutna Hora, a rare medieval gem of a city once known for mining silver. Tour the Gothic Church of St. Barbara, the Sedlec Ossuary (Bone Church) and the Cathedral of Our Lady. The Sedlec Ossuary is a chapel richly decorated with the bones of an estimated 40,000 to 70,000 people! The Cathedral of Our Lady of the Assumption at Sedlec has a unique combination of gothic and baroque architecture and is part of a historic site on the UNESCO World Heritage List. After visiting the Cathedral board the bus enroute for Krakow with dinner on the way. Overnight in Krakow.

### DAY 5 WADOWICE / CZĘSTOCHOWA

After breakfast depart to Wadowice, the birthplace of Karol Józef Wojtyła, who was elected Pope John Paul II in 1978. Tour the historic museum known as "The family home of Pope John Paul II - Papal Museum." Then in the afternoon we will drive to the world famous Marian pilgrimage site of Our Lady of Czestochowa in the Jasna Gora Monastery. Later we will return to the hotel in Krakow for dinner and overnight.

### DAY 6 KRAKOW

Today is dedicated to touring Krakow, one of the few ancient cities spared the mass destruction of World War II. For centuries it was the residence of the Polish kings. See the Market Square, the 14th Century University, St. Mary's Basilica and the Chapel of the Miraculous Image of the Merciful Jesus and Tomb of St. Faustina. Later on, we will visit Wawel Royal Cathedral and St. Florian's Basilica. Return to your hotel for dinner and overnight.

### DAY 7 WIELICZKA SALT MINES / AUSCHWITZ CAMP

Drive in the morning to Wieliczka to visit the oldest salt mine in Europe. In this one of a kind place many generations of Polish miners have created an underground world of richly decorated chapels including the famous Blessed Kings Chapel, plus other galleries and works made of salt. The Wieliczka Salt Mine is listed by UNESCO as an object of World Heritage. Continue to the Nazi concentration camp of Auschwitz, to tour and pray for the victims of the Holocaust. After seeing the cell of the Franciscan Martyr, St. Maximilian Kolbe who gave his life in place of another man who was condemned to die, return to the hotel in Krakow for dinner and overnight.

### DAY 8 ZAKOPANE / BANSKA BYSTRICA

After breakfast, drive through the mountains to the breathtaking village of Zakopane. Take a cable car ride up the mountaintop to take in God's creation and the awesome panoramic view. Following the many photos captured atop the mountain, visit the Jaszczorowka Chapel. The young Karol Wojtyla (Saint John Paul II) visited this architecturally distinct chapel often for prayer and reflection. After experiencing this beautiful chapel, walk the colorful Krupowki Street to do some local shopping. Board the bus for a beautiful drive into Slovakia and visit the famous medieval Oravsky Castle. Drive to Banska Bystrica for dinner and overnight.

## DAY 9 BANSKA BYSTRICA / HRONSEK / KREMNICA

We start the day with a tour of Banská Bystrica. Visit the magnificent Cathedral of St. Francis Xavier, located on SNP Square, and the Church of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary with a notable history dating back to the 13th century. Visit the Hronsek Wooden Church (a UNESCO site) and the Clock Tower, which was rebuilt in 1769 after a devastating fire damaged the original 1552 structure. Here you have an opportunity to climb the Clock Tower's 117 wooden stairs to take in the local view. Continue on to see the Mirian Pillar then travel to Kremnica, a beautiful medieval mining city. Tour the Museum of Coins and Metals. Visit Kremnica Castle and the Church of St. Catherine. Back to Banská Bystrica for dinner and overnight.

## DAY 10 BANSKA STIAVNICA

After breakfast, board the bus and have an orientation tour of the city of Banská Stiavnica. This will include the Kalvaria, Old Castle, Namestie Svätej Trojice (The Holy Trinity Town Square), Banskostiavnicky Bethlehem. We will also visit the magnificent Castle Museum of Svätý Anton. Then drive to Bojnica Castle and tour one of the most famous landmarks of Slovakia. Return to your hotel in Banská Bystrica for dinner and overnight.

## DAY 11 BUDAPEST

Today we leave Slovakia and cross the border into Hungary through the region of Transdanubia. Stop in Esztergom to visit the Cathedral, then visit Bory Castle. Continue to Budapest, see Buda Castle Heroes Square, and view the Hungarian Parliament Building. Continue to your hotel in Budapest for dinner and overnight.

We will have Mass at the famous St. Stephen Church and then see the Castle Hill area. For our final evening, relax and enjoy a Dinner Cruise on the Danube. Then transfer to your hotel for overnight.

## TERMS AND CONDITIONS

### The Tour Price Includes:

**Air Transportation:** Airfare is based on special contract agreements with various international airlines and include certain restrictions and deadlines. These fares are subject to cancellation penalties, and once tickets are issued, they are **NON-REFUNDABLE, NON-TRANSFERABLE AND CANNOT BE USED TOWARDS FUTURE TRAVEL**. Please refer to our CANCELLATION AND REFUND POLICY below. Airfare and tour prices are based on prices effective as of **JANUARY 1, 2026** and are subject to change without notice.

**Surface/Land Transportation:** All surface/land transportation described in the itinerary will be provided by modern motor coach, designed for highway travel. Groups will be met and transferred upon arrival and departure.

**Hotels:** We only use first-class hotels. Hotel accommodations are based on double occupancy (2 per room). We reserve the right to substitute hotels of similar quality for those specified in the itinerary.

**Single Room Supplements:** If you would like a single room, there is an additional cost of **\$1,300.00** that will be added to the tour price. Single rooms are limited and will be reserved on a first come first serve basis. If you request a roommate and none is available, you will be considered a "forced single," and charged one half (½) of the Single Room Supplement cost.

**Meal Plan:** Meal plans include two (2) meals per day, breakfast and dinner, with timing depending on the itinerary. Taxes and service charges normally appearing on restaurant bills are included in the tour price for these meals. **A list of any and all dietary requests or food allergies must be emailed to [cathy@inspirationaltoursinc.com](mailto:cathy@inspirationaltoursinc.com) for hotel/airline accommodation at least seven (7) days before departure.** We cannot guarantee any dietary accommodations but will make all efforts to secure special dietary requests. In the event airlines or hotels are unable to accommodate dietary requests, you will be responsible for your meals; it is the individual's responsibility to choose appropriate foods while on the tour. Unused meals will NOT be reimbursed.

**Baggage:** Inspirational Tours, Inc. restricts all passengers to one (1) piece of checked luggage (max. 50 lbs.) and one (1) carry-on (max. 18 lbs.). **All passengers should check with the airline for up-to-date baggage weight/dimension information and restrictions, which are subject to change at any time before departure.**

**Airport Taxes and Fuel Surcharges:** are included in the tour price and are subject to change.

**Tips On The Tour:** Tips to guides, porters, headwaiters, and drivers are included in the tour price, unless otherwise specified.

**The Tour Price Does Not Include: *Tips On Board The Cruise.*** Expenses related to issuance / renewal of passports, laundry, mineral waters, wine & liquor not mentioned in the itinerary, after-lunch/dinner tea, coffee, or food not included in the meal plan above; additional baggage; expenses of carriages, guides, sightseeing or other services other than those specifically mentioned as included in the itinerary; insurance for baggage or personal trip or health insurance; all items of a personal nature, in addition to those not listed above as being included in the tour price.

**Booking Conditions: Deposits and Payment: A non-refundable deposit of \$300.00 per person,** payable via cash, check or money order, is required at the time of registration. No registration will be processed without a deposit. Invoices for final balances are issued at or near 90 days before departure. Full and final payment is due 60 days before departure. Registrations received within 90 days of departure require payment in full. If there is any outstanding balance by the Final Payment due date listed on your invoice, all travel services will be subject to automatic cancellation and cancellation fees will apply. A service reinstatement fee may be added to your invoice and must be paid in advance in order to apply for reconfirmation of services. **WE ONLY ACCEPT CASH, CHECKS OR MONEY ORDERS FOR THE REGISTRATION FEE.** Payment by credit card is accepted ONLY for final balances or payments towards final balances; all credit card payments will be assessed a **3% non-refundable** convenience fee, which will be added to the total amount being charged.

**Cancellations and Refund Policy:** All cancellations **MUST BE RECEIVED IN WRITING VIA FAX, E-MAIL OR U.S. MAIL.** The date of the cancellation request is the date used for purposes of any assessed cancellation fees. Please note that some Registration Fees are NON-REFUNDABLE as stated on the Registration Form. Cancellation fees (as to any monies paid over the deposit for a tour with a non-refundable deposit) depend on the timing of the cancellation request, and are as follows: request received between time of registration and up to 59 to 45 days prior to departure—cancellation fee of **50%** of tour cost; request received 44 days or less prior to departure through date of departure—assessed **100%** of the tour cost (air and land, and any deviation fees) as the cancellation fee. Additional charges/fees for deviations and/or upgraded seats may require full payment at time of booking/confirmation, and may be non-refundable; **if a non-refundable air ticket has been issued prior to receiving notice of a cancellation request, you will be 100% responsible for those fees, in addition to the cancellation penalties listed above.** Package cancellation fees include airfare. Once airfare is purchased, either at time of booking, including but not limited to, deviations or seat upgrade requests, or at time of full payment, airline tickets will be issued and are always subject to a 100% penalty. Once full payment is received, Inspirational Tours, Inc. will issue airline tickets, which are non-refundable. If the tour is canceled for any reason, including but not limited to, tour leader's decision, decision of Inspirational Tours, Inc., weather or natural disasters, strike, acts of war, terrorism, acts of god, quarantine, disease, virus, epidemic, pandemic, compliance with government orders, travel restrictions issued by the U.S. Department of State, or any other force majeure event, Inspirational Tours, Inc. reserves the right to charge a minimum \$300.00 administrative fee per person, plus any non-reimbursable expenses incurred from airlines and/or overseas operators. **ALL RESERVATIONS ARE NON-TRANSFERABLE AT ANY TIME FOR ANY REASON.**

**Deviations/Seat Upgrades:** Deviation policies vary by airline and are normally allowed only on the return journey, **from the same departing city as the group, and is subject to availability.** There is a **minimum** change fee of \$150.00 per person, plus any additional airline charges. Seat upgrade requests may also require additional fees by the airlines and vary. Any additional fees required to be paid by the airline for deviation requests and/or seat upgrade

requests will need to be approved by the passenger in writing before confirmed/reserved, and if the request requires payment at the time of confirmation, this must be paid by the passenger at the time requested, and may be non-refundable. **ALL deviation or seat upgrade requests must be made in writing, at least 90 days prior to your departure date.**

**Tour Prices:** All tour prices quoted for transportation and land arrangements in this tour are based on rates, (including foreign exchange rates), in effect at the time of the original tour agreement with your tour host and Inspirational Tours, Inc. and are subject to increase without notice prior to departure. **NOTE:** Our tours are based on a minimum number of participants. We reserve the right to cancel or reschedule any tour for any reason including insufficient participants, or events beyond our control. Any cancellation will be advised at the soonest date possible. Inspirational Tours, Inc. will not be held responsible for any costs related to the issuance and/or cancellation of airline tickets or visa fees that are not refunded by those entities.

**Travel Insurance:** To protect your travel plans, **WE HIGHLY RECOMMEND THE PURCHASE OF TRIP INSURANCE.** A brochure for a company we recommend will be provided with your deposit confirmation letter, upon our receipt of your registration and deposit. We do not sell travel insurance and travel insurance is not included in the tour price.

**Passports: It is your responsibility to provide us with a copy of your current passport with your Registration Form. Validity date on passports must be for at least six (6) months after the date of return of the tour as per the tour dates, or any deviation request.** If we do not receive a copy of your current passport, the information you provide on your Registration Form will be used for ticketing purposes. If ANY information provided (name, date of birth, etc.) does not match what is on your passport, you may be subject to penalties or fees for corrections to airline tickets, and/or may be denied boarding by the airline. Any name change, including minor spelling corrections, may require reservations to be canceled and re-booked. Reservations will then be subject to availability and pricing at the time of re-booking; any increase in airfare will be borne by the passenger. Inspirational Tours, Inc. will not be held responsible for the denial of services by a carrier due to any name or passport discrepancies. If you have a passport issued from any country other than the U.S., it is your responsibility to contact the embassies of the countries to be visited to determine if a visa will be required, and if so, it will be your responsibility to obtain such visa before departure.
