### DAY 1 DEPARTURE FROM ORLANDO

Today you will depart from Orlando International Airport (MCO) on your overnight flight to London, beginning your unforgettable Catholic heritage journey through England and Scotland. Overnight flight.

### DAY 2 ARRIVAL IN LONDON – WESTMINSTER & CATHOLIC LONDON

Welcome to England! Upon arrival in London, you will be met and transferred into the heart of the city. After time to refresh and settle into your hotel, your pilgrimage begins with one of London's most iconic spiritual and historic landmarks. Your first visit will be to the magnificent Westminster area, where you will enjoy a guided tour of Westminster Abbey, the historic church of coronations, royal weddings, and burials for nearly 1,000 years. The Abbey stands as one of the greatest examples of Gothic architecture in Europe. You will also have the opportunity to view the Houses of Parliament and the famous Big Ben from the outside while learning about the rich political and religious history of England. In the early evening, attend Holy Mass at Westminster Cathedral, the mother church of Catholics in England and Wales. The Cathedral's stunning Byzantine architecture and sacred atmosphere make for a beautiful beginning to your pilgrimage. Dinner at the hotel and overnight in London.

### DAY 3 TOWER OF LONDON, THAMES RIVER & LONDON HIGHLIGHTS

After breakfast, depart early for the Tower of London, arriving before the crowds for a guided exploration of this legendary fortress. Discover nearly 1,000 years of royal history while viewing the Crown Jewels and medieval towers. Learn about the stories of kings, queens, saints, and martyrs. Celebrate daily Holy Mass at the nearby Church of the English Martyrs, located at Tower Hill. This church serves as a moving reminder of the Catholic martyrs who remained faithful during the English Reformation. Continue your day with a relaxing river cruise along the River Thames, offering spectacular views of London's famous landmarks including Tower Bridge, St. Paul's Cathedral, Shakespeare's Globe, and the Houses of Parliament. Later, enjoy a ride on the iconic London Eye for panoramic views across the city skyline. This afternoon, visit the world-renowned National Gallery in Trafalgar Square, home to masterpieces by Leonardo da Vinci, Caravaggio, Van Gogh, Rembrandt, and countless other artists. Dinner and overnight in London.

### DAY 4 ARUNDEL, WINCHESTER & ENGLAND'S MEDIEVAL HERITAGE

Following breakfast, depart London and travel south into the beautiful English countryside toward Arundel. Your first stop will be the breathtaking Cathedral of Our Lady and St. Philip Howard, commonly known as Arundel Cathedral. This magnificent Gothic Revival church is one of England's most impressive Catholic cathedrals and serves as a powerful symbol of the restoration of Catholic life in England. Celebrate Holy Mass before enjoying time to tour the cathedral and admire its architecture, stained glass, and sacred atmosphere. Next, visit Arundel Castle, one of England's finest medieval castles and ancestral home of the Dukes of Norfolk. Explore the historic interiors, impressive grounds, and centuries of English noble history. Continue onward to the historic city of Winchester, once the capital of Anglo-Saxon England. Upon arrival, enjoy a guided visit of Winchester Cathedral, one of the largest cathedrals in Europe and final resting place of Jane Austen. You will also have time to stroll through Winchester's charming medieval streets. Dinner and overnight in Winchester.

### DAY 5 STONEHENGE, SALISBURY & MOTTISFONT ABBEY

Begin the day with morning Mass at St. Peter's Catholic Church in Winchester. After Mass, depart for one of the world's most mysterious ancient monuments: Stonehenge. Standing on the Salisbury Plain for over 4,000 years, this UNESCO World Heritage Site continues to fascinate visitors from around the globe. Continue to the beautiful city of Salisbury to visit Salisbury Cathedral, famous for its soaring spire — the tallest in Britain — and for housing one of the original surviving copies of the Magna Carta. Later this afternoon, visit the peaceful grounds of Mottisfont Abbey, a former medieval priory transformed into a beautiful country estate surrounded by gardens and riverside scenery. Return to Winchester. Dinner and overnight in Winchester.

### DAY 6 WINDSOR CASTLE & CAMBRIDGE

Following morning Mass at St. Peter's Catholic Church, depart Winchester for Windsor. Visit Windsor Castle, the oldest and largest occupied castle in the world and one of the official residences of the British monarch. Tour the magnificent State Apartments, St. George's Chapel, and the beautiful castle grounds. Afterward, continue north to the historic university city of Cambridge. Upon arrival, enjoy a guided city tour through the picturesque streets and colleges that have shaped centuries of

academic and intellectual life. Admire famous colleges such as King's College, Trinity College, and St. John's College while learning about Cambridge's remarkable history. Enjoy free time this evening to stroll along the River Cam or experience the lively atmosphere of this elegant university city. Dinner and overnight in Cambridge.

### **DAY 7 WALSINGHAM, ELY & CAMBRIDGE**

Today's journey takes you to one of England's most important pilgrimage destinations. Travel to Walsingham, often called "England's Nazareth," where devotion to Our Lady has drawn pilgrims for centuries. Visit the ancient Shrine of Our Lady of Walsingham and celebrate Mass at the Slipper Chapel. Following time for prayer and reflection, continue to the city of Ely. Visit the magnificent Ely Cathedral, known as the "Ship of the Fens" due to its towering presence above the surrounding countryside. This architectural masterpiece is celebrated for its stunning octagonal lantern tower and remarkable medieval craftsmanship. Return to Cambridge in the late afternoon. This evening, perhaps enjoy one of Cambridge's classic experiences such as punting along the River Cam, an elegant tradition offering beautiful views of the colleges from the water. Dinner and overnight in Cambridge.

### **DAY 8 YORK & THE MEDIEVAL NORTH**

After breakfast, depart Cambridge and travel north to the historic city of York, one of England's best-preserved medieval cities. Upon arrival, enjoy a guided tour through York's ancient streets, including the famous Shambles, Roman walls, and charming medieval lanes. Visit the magnificent York Minster, one of the greatest Gothic cathedrals in Northern Europe, renowned for its extraordinary stained glass and remarkable history. Celebrate Holy Mass at St. Wilfrid's Church, home of the York Oratory and one of the principal Catholic churches in northern England. You will also have free time to explore York's shops, cafés, and historic atmosphere. Dinner and overnight in York.

### **DAY 9 BAMBURGH CASTLE & ARRIVAL IN EDINBURGH**

This morning, attend Mass either in York before departure or upon arrival in Edinburgh. Travel north through the beautiful landscapes of northern England to Bamburgh Castle, dramatically situated above the North Sea coastline. Enjoy time to tour the castle and take in the spectacular coastal scenery. Continue onward into Scotland and arrive in the elegant capital city of Edinburgh. Upon arrival, enjoy a walking tour through Edinburgh's historic Royal Mile and Old Town. Visit Edinburgh Castle, perched high above the city on its volcanic rock, and discover the fascinating history of Scotland's kings, queens, and national heritage. Dinner and overnight in Edinburgh.

### **DAY 10 EDINBURGH – PALACES, GALLERIES & SCOTTISH HERITAGE**

Begin the day with morning Mass at either St. Mary's Cathedral or St. Patrick's Catholic Church. Today you will explore more of Scotland's magnificent capital. Visit the Palace of Holyroodhouse, the official Scottish residence of the British monarch and one of the most historically significant royal palaces in Scotland. This afternoon, enjoy time at the National Galleries of Scotland, home to an outstanding collection of European and Scottish masterpieces. You may also enjoy free time to explore Edinburgh's charming streets, cafés, gardens, and shops. Dinner and overnight in Edinburgh.

### **DAY 11 SCOTTISH HIGHLANDS, GLENCOE & LOCH LOMOND**

After morning Mass, depart Edinburgh and journey into the breathtaking landscapes of the Scottish Highlands. Travel through some of Scotland's most spectacular scenery including Glencoe, where you will view the famous Three Sisters peaks and the majestic Buachaille Etive Mòr. Stop for lunch in the village of Tarbet before continuing to Loch Lomond. This afternoon, enjoy a scenic boat cruise on Loch Lomond, the largest inland stretch of water in Great Britain and one of Scotland's most beautiful natural treasures. Dinner and overnight in Glasgow.

### **DAY 12 GLASGOW, STIRLING CASTLE & SCOTTISH CULTURE**

Begin your final full day with morning Mass at Glasgow's Catholic Cathedral. Afterward, travel to the historic city of Stirling, often called the "Gateway to the Highlands." Visit Stirling Castle, one of Scotland's grandest castles and a key site in Scottish history associated with Mary Queen of Scots and William Wallace. Later, enjoy a visit to a traditional Scottish distillery in the Doune area where you will learn about the craftsmanship and heritage behind Scotland's famous whisky traditions. Return to Glasgow in the afternoon and visit the renowned Kelvingrove Art Gallery and Museum, one of Scotland's most beloved museums featuring art, history, and natural collections. This evening, gather for a final dinner celebrating the conclusion of your pilgrimage and cultural journey. Overnight in Glasgow.

### **DAY 13 DEPARTURE**

Today you will transfer to the airport for your return flight home.

## The Tour Price Includes:

**Air Transportation:** Airfare is based on special contract agreements with various international airlines and include certain restrictions and deadlines. These fares are subject to cancellation penalties, and once tickets are issued, they are **NON-REFUNDABLE, NON-TRANSFERABLE AND CANNOT BE USED TOWARDS FUTURE TRAVEL**. **Surface/Land Transportation:** All surface/land transportation described in the itinerary will be provided by modern motor coach, designed for highway travel. Groups will be met and transferred upon arrival and departure.

**Hotels:** We only use first-class hotels. Hotel accommodations are based on double occupancy (2 per room). We reserve the right to substitute hotels of similar quality for those specified in the itinerary.

**Single Room Supplements:** If you would like a single room, there is an additional cost of **\$1,500.00** that will be added to the tour price. Single rooms are limited and will be reserved on a first come first serve basis. If you request a roommate and none is available, you will be considered a "forced single," and charged one half (½) of the Single Room Supplement cost.

**Meal Plan:** Meal plans include two (2) meals per day, breakfast and dinner, with timing depending on the itinerary. Taxes and service charges normally appearing on restaurant bills are included in the tour price for these meals. **A list of any and all dietary requests or food allergies must be emailed to [cathy@inspirationaltoursinc.com](mailto:cathy@inspirationaltoursinc.com) for hotel / airline accommodation at least seven (7) days before departure.** We cannot guarantee any dietary accommodations but will make all efforts to secure special dietary requests. **Cancellations and Refund Policy:** All cancellations **MUST BE RECEIVED IN WRITING VIA FAX, E-MAIL OR U.S. MAIL**. The date of the cancellation request is the date used for purposes of any assessed cancellation fees. Please note that some Registration Fees are NON-REFUNDABLE as stated on the Registration Form. Cancellation fees (as to any monies paid over the deposit for a tour with a non-refundable deposit) depend on the timing of the cancellation request, and are as follows: request received between time of registration and up to 59 to 45 days prior to departure—cancellation fee of **50%** of tour cost; request received 44 days or less prior to departure through date of departure—assessed **100%** of the tour cost (air and land, and any deviation fees) as the cancellation fee.
