A GREENER, GENTLER ALTERNATIVE

Water cremation is a gentle, eco-friendly alternative to flame cremation. Just like with traditional cremation, water cremation is a method of final disposition that reduces the body to essential elements, which are then returned to the family. However, no flames are used during the water cremation process, making it a more natural choice. Originally developed by the Mayo Clinic, this revolutionary process is now available to the general public through English Funeral Chapel.

Since 1941, we have focused on creating meaningful events to celebrate each unique life lived. As innovators in the funeral industry, we are committed to providing state-of-the-art services that distinguish us from other providers. That is why we are proud to offer a gentle, flameless alternative to traditional cremation.

WATER CREMATION PROCESS

The scientific name for this water-based process is alkaline hydrolysis. It is the same process that occurs as part of nature's course when a body is laid to rest in the soil. We use a combination of water flow, temperature, and alkalinity to accelerate nature's process.

The Aquamation process is performed after any viewing, visitation, or funeral services the family wishes to have. When it's time for the process, the individual body is respectfully placed in a stainless steel vessel. Alkali is added to the process based on individual characteristics (weight, sex, embalming status), and the vessel fills with water. The solution of 95% water and 5% alkali is heated to 200-300°F, and gently circulated for the entire length of the process.

At the end of the process, all material is broken down to the smallest building blocks; there is no DNA or RNA remaining. The sterile process water is released for recycling (our bodies are approximately 65% water to begin with), and the vessel performs a fresh water rinse for the equipment and remains. When the operator opens the door, only the inorganic bone minerals remain. These minerals are processed into powder and returned to the family in an urn. This final processing step is the same process that is followed with flame cremation. Many families hold a celebration of life or gathering when the loved one's remains are returned to the family's care.

With Aquamation, there are no direct emissions of harmful greenhouse gases or mercury into the atmosphere. This process does not burn any fossil fuels. It is very energy efficient - greater than 90% energy savings compared to flame cremation, with 1/10th of the carbon footprint. Because Aquamation uses electricity, it will move into the future as our society improves infrastructure for cleaner energy sources – like wind, water, and solar energy. The Aquamation process uses less water than a single household uses in one day (source: watr.usgs.gov). This includes all of the water used for the process, along with the clean water rinsing of the final remains and vessel.

Peace of Mind Water Cremation

English Funeral Chapels Crematory and Aquamation Center is the only local cremation provider to offer a 10-step cremation process backed by our "Cremation with Peace of Mind" pledge. We are also the only local provider that uses a dual Identification System to ensure that the cremated remains returned to you are those of your loved one.

If your preference is cremation, there is no other choice than English

Steps Prior to Cremation

1. Our dual ankle identification bands are placed on your loved one at the time we come to your home, hospital or other care facility. The metal ID system is a high quality stainless steel band and label. A unique tracking number is embossed into the stainless steel label, providing a permanent identification marker never to be duplicated on another ID band.
2. Our licensed funeral director and staff coordinates with obtaining proper documentation including:
 - Death certificate signed by the Attending Physician or Coroner with cause of death listed
 - Fully executed and signed Cremation Authorization
 - Final Disposition Cremation Permit issued by the Coroner
3. If you wish, before cremation, you may see your loved one, hold their hand and say goodbye. If your loved one is not embalmed this is strictly limited to no more than three (3) family members for 5 minutes. This must be scheduled during regular business hours.
4. One of our licensed funeral directors reviews all cremation paperwork and permits to insure authorizations and permits have been received. A licensed funeral director must sign the crematory record.



Steps During and After Cremation

5. Our Crematory Record is dated, start time noted and signed immediately before the cremation takes place.
6. Your loved one is assigned a cremation number. This number is placed on the identification label and accompanies your loved one throughout the entire process.
7. Your loved one is removed from our refrigeration facility, placed in the cremation container that was chosen during the arrangement conference, placed in the retort and cremated.
8. The identification label is placed at the door of the cremation chamber during the cremation process.
9. After the cremation is completed, the cremated remains and stainless steel ID band are retrieved from the cremation chamber and taken to the processing station and allowed to cool. The identification label and ID band are placed on the processing machine following cremation process.

If legal or other requirements mean you must buy any items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral goods and services you selected.

BASIC SERVICES OF FUNERAL DIRECTOR AND STAFF \$1,995 _____

Our fee for the basic services of funeral director and staff includes, but is not limited to, staff to respond to initial request for service; arrangement conference with family and responsible parties; arrangement of funeral; preparation and filing of necessary authorizations and permits; recording vital statistics; preparation and placement of obituary notice; and coordination with those providing other portions of the funeral, e.g., cemetery, crematory, vault companies and others as required. Also included in this charge are overhead expenses relative to our facilities such as sheltering of remains, professional licensing, legal and accounting fees, insurance, building and utility expenses, parking lot and grounds, maintenance, taxes, equipment, furnishings, inventory costs, recordkeeping, and secretarial and administrative expenses.

This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. (This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremations, immediate burials, and forwarding or receiving remains.)

EMBALMING \$650 _____

Embalming is a chemical process which provides temporary preservation of the body and eliminates certain health hazards. A person licensed by the State of Idaho must complete this procedure. Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial.
