Apparently enroute to join General Washington at Trenton, Major Galbraith and others were captured by the British. From 1776 to 1782, British forces occupying New York City used abandoned or decommissioned warships anchored near the current location of the Brooklyn Navy Yard to hold soldiers and sailors, had captured on land or sea. Also arrested were any civilians who refused to swear an oath of allegiance to the British Crown. Some 11,000 prisoners died aboard the prison ships over the course of the war, most from disease or malnutrition. Many of these were inmates of the infamous HMS Jersey, where nearly 1,000 prisoners at a time, including Galbraith, were held below decks. "The Old Jersey" was the most notorious of these prison ships, and earned the nickname "Hell Ship" for its inhumane conditions and the obscenely high death rate of its prisoners. Major Galbraith, however, was repatriated before the war's end, and after the conflict he returned to his law practice in Cumberland County.




Historical Note : Conestoga wagons were first used to haul farm products to the Philadelphia markets. Later, as the frontier moved westward, wagon trains would cross the Susquehanna River at Simpson's Ferry, continuing to Mechanicsburg (where "wheelright mechanics" could mend or replace their wagon wheels). Then the trail west (now <u>Trindle</u> Rd.) led to an overnight at <u>Trindle</u> Springs Farm, where water and grazing land was available. Enterprising wagonmasters would often buy cigars in the area, selling them at western destinations. Having arrived in conestoga wagons; the cigars became known as "conestogies" (later, "stogies")

MAPS

INFORMATION SOURCES

- 1892 Map by surveyor A.B. Rupp - showed numbered graves but not names. Some were later identified and transcribed in the margin.
- Circa 1902 map, revised in 1936, and 1940. Hand-drawn by Trustees and Pastor T. J. Ferguson. Framed and hangs in church parlor.
- 1968 Map, by engineer William Whittock. Prepared when certain aisles were eliminated to permit plotting of additional graves.
- 2002 "Overview" map (revised 2018 as the front cover of this directory). Shows location of each 50' x 50' quadrant and of each row. The accompanying alphabetical directory cross-references the quadrant or row location of each known grave-holder.

EARLY HISTORY OF SILVER SPRING PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH

- Prepared for the 175th Anniversary of the Church, in 1909. Developed by Church Historian E. Rankin Huston.
- Text of address given Aug. 5, 1909 by noted Cumberland County Historian Jeremiah Zeamer entitled *Early Patriots of the Silver Spring*

SURVEYS AND TRANSCRIPTIONS OF THE GRAVESTONES

- 1901 survey by Cumberland County Historian J. Zeamer, with 613 names. Typescript prepared by D.A.R.'s Miss Helen Harman.
- 1912-1913 survey by E. Rankin Huston, listing 667 names. His notes were later typed by 30-year Church secretary Vera Shaull Fittler.
- 1998-2000 survey by Margaret Westbrook and Bill Spoon, with 997 names. Published in 2002 and updated periodically.
- This March, 2018 revision of the alphabetical directory of graveholders identifies--> 1,101 known utilized and reserved graves)
A. B. Rupp's 1892 map numbers each grave but without names. Hundreds on his + 845 unknown names see note at left)
map (our oldest) have been identified (from surviving gravestones). These were **1,946** TOTAL as of March, 2018
later annotated on map's margin, thus are included in this directory. However,
845 remain unidentified (some may be reserved, rather than utilized graves).

5 two-person below-ground crypts for conventional burial remain available, and 400+ cremation niches were also available as of March, 2018.

STATE LIBRARY DOCUMENTS

- In 2000, a book of typewritten pages, *Revolutionary War Veterans Interred in Pennsylvania* was discovered in the State archives. It credits 39 as having been buried at Silver Spring Presbyterian, including members of the county militia not often listed elsewhere.
- Genealogists' note: In addition to Silver Spring *Presbyterian* Cemetery, there is also a *Silver Spring* Cemetery in Lancaster County, PA.

- This organization, in Carlisle (PA) has extensive genealogical/biographical records that have proven helpful to those researching family histories, land-holdings, tax rolls, and census records.

CEMETERY RESTORATION

- In addition to the year-2011 restoration (see "A Brief History" - inside front cover), in 2017 church member Terry Jones led a team of volunteers in the re-installation of 96 leaning gravestones that were in danger of toppling. Periodically the church contracts for *professional* restoration of broken gravestones, using mortar developed in Germany that expands and contracts at the same rate as granite (common mortar is unsatisfactory). Such a project, by Robert Mosko Cemetery Restoration Inc.(Hanover), will begin in 2018.

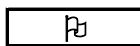
