

JUBILEE 2025 FOCUS RECONCILIATION & INDULGENCE



Our scheduled parish local pilgrimages have completed. However, one can schedule a personal pilgrimage to our diocesan Jubilee church: the Cathedral of St. Joseph. On this personal pilgrimage, focus on the jubilee sign of reconciliation and indulgence. You may also use the Pilgrimage Prayer posted on our parish website or use this QR code:



Jubilee year is a sign of reconciliation because it establishes a "favorable time" (cf. 2 Corinthians 6:2) for conversion. We are called to put God at the center of our lives, growing toward Him and acknowledging His primacy. Concretely, reconciliation is about experiencing the sacrament of Reconciliation, taking advantage of this time to rediscover the value of confession, and personally receiving God's word of forgiveness. There are some Jubilee churches that continuously offer the possibility for Reconciliation. Indulgence is a concrete manifestation of God's mercy, which surpasses and transforms the boundaries of human justice. This gift of grace came about by Jesus' saving mission. Seeing the witnesses of Jesus and the saints and living in communion with them, our hope for our own forgiveness is strengthened. Concretely, the experience of God's mercy involves some spiritual actions, as Pope Francis has recommended to the faithful. Those who cannot make the Jubilee pilgrimage due to illness or other circumstances are nevertheless invited to take part in the spiritual journey that accompanies this Jubilee year. Among the conditions for receiving the indulgence is praying for the Pope's intentions.

All Saints Day and All Souls Day, celebrated on November 1 & 2, are times for the church to commemorate the communion of saints. 


PAST GRAND KNIGHTS DINNER & AWARDS NIGHT: TUESDAY, NOVEMBER II

BLOOD DRIVE AT ASCENSION PARISH: SUNDAY, NOVEMBER 16

The next blood drive at Ascension Parish will take place on Sunday, November 16 from 9:00 am to 2:00 pm in the parking lot. Your photo ID will be required, so please come prepared and arrive hydrated. You can schedule an appointment by scanning the QR code to the right, or by calling 619-400-8251; walk-ins are also welcome.

WHY SHOULD I DONATE BLOOD?

- 5M people in the U.S. need blood every year
- One pint of blood can save up to three lives
- An average person has 11 pints of blood—only one pint is drawn when you donate
- Since a pint is a pound, you lose a pound every time you donate
- You can donate blood every 56 days
- About one in seven people entering a hospital need blood
- A pint of blood at a hospital costs around \$250-\$300
- Every two seconds, someone needs a blood transfusion
- More than 14 tests are performed on each unit of donated blood
- You cannot contract any disease by donating blood
- About three gallons of blood supports the entire nation's blood needs for only one minute
- 37% of the U.S. population are eligible to donate BUT only 5% donate yearly
- Blood cannot be manufactured—not yet anyway
- It feels great to donate because you helped saved a life!

At Ascension Parish, we have our own Blood Fund. If you, your immediate family, relatives, neighbors or friends need blood, just ask! The blood from our fund is FREE—we DO NOT charge for the needed blood. We hope to see you at our next Blood Drive!
