

Ascension is looking for you to join our team and play a vital role in mentoring our middle school and high school teens and fostering a deeper connection to our rich Catholic spiritual heritage.



MINISTRIES OF CHARITY UPDATE

Dear Friends in Christ,

We just celebrated Three Kings Day, the Feast of the Epiphany of Our Lord. Our Christmas season, especially in this feast, reminds us that anyone who comes to meet our newborn king always come away changed. What has changed for you? Are you looking for a way to find Jesus, maybe in the needy or in the homeless? Please join us as we continue to serve those in need. Our next event is called "Help for the Homeless." You can read about all our activities in the parish bulletin, on the parish website, and here is your next MOC Update #2024 -1.

HELP FOR THE HOMELESS:

Our first MOC 2024 event, "Help for the Homeless", is a project to serve the Homeless in San Diego. This event will be two separate, simultaneous projects. The first project will benefit the children from the Department of Children and Youth in Transition (CYT), within the San Diego City School District. This little known department serves all children within the school system who are living in transitional situations. This includes children who are homeless, or in transitional housing, i.e. military and immigrant families in need. Children from these situations are regularly in crisis and are served by CYT with school supplies, clothes and food.

What is their most critical need? Believe it or not, children's underwear. Many, many of these children do not have new or clean underwear. CYT's closets are empty. Please help, we will be accepting donations, throughout January, of new children's underwear: Kindergarten to 12th grade, boy's and girl's, all sizes. Help us send these children to school dressed appropriately.

The second project, will be a collection of shoes (new or gently used) and socks for homeless adults (both men's and women's adult sizes). Please look through your closets for shoes you no longer use that are still in good shape. We can use them. Payless Shoes, Walmart, TJ Max, and Marshall's often have inexpensive shoes for sale. If you cannot go out and shop, write Ascension a MOC check and we will be glad to shop for you.

We will be having a distribution of these and other items, as well as, serving a meal at Catholic Charities' Neil Good Center on Feb 10, 2024, from 9am to 12pm

Collections for all these items have begun and will continue through the first week of February 2024. Donation bins are in the vestibule of the Church.

Please help fill our bins.

We will be looking for many volunteers to help sort, pack, and load items. We will be looking for trucks, vans, SUVs, and drivers the morning of the event to transport items. We will need volunteers to set up, distribute items and serve lunch at the event. Please consider helping us. Maybe you will find Jesus there. We will be having a signup table to help for this event outside of church after weekend masses the 3rd and 4th weekends in January.
