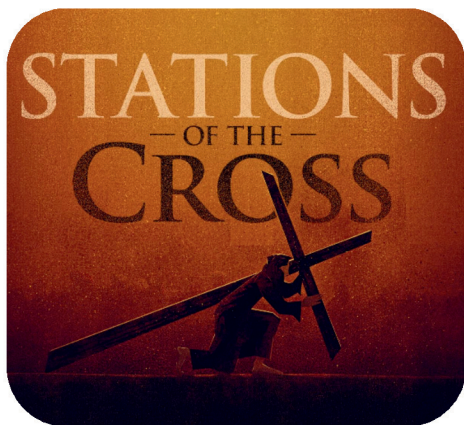

STATIONS OF THE CROSS - EVERY FRIDAY DURING LENT AT 5:30



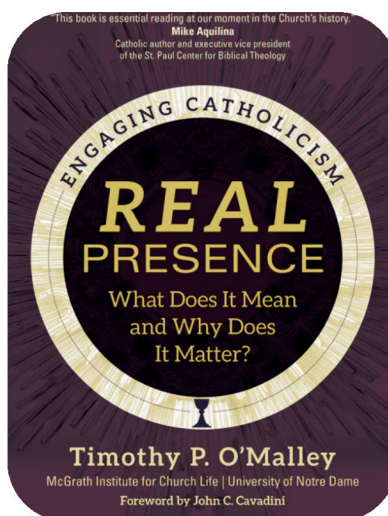
