REST IN PEACE, MONSIGNOR NEAL DOLAN

With great sadness, we announce the death of Ascension Catholic Parish's founding Pastor, Monsignor Neal Dolan. Monsignor Neal peacefully passed into the arms of his Savior in the early morning hours of July 7, 2026 surrounded by his family.

Father Neal Dolan was Director of the Permanent Diaconate in 1980 when Bishop Leo T. Maher asked him to establish Ascension Catholic Parish in Tierrasanta in 1980. The first Holy Masses were held at Miller Elementary School, and the parish church was dedicated in 1985. He led the parish through 1987. Afterwards, Monsignor Dolan held numerous ministerial assignments around the diocese. His last pastorate was at St. Michael's Parish in Poway.

Monsignor Neal was a beloved priest in the San Diego Diocese by his brother priests, his family, friends, and parishioners. Funeral arrangements are pending. Please keep Monsignor Neal and the Dolan Family in your prayers.

MINISTRY HIGHLIGHT: BEREAVEMENT TEAM

Ministry Overview

The Bereavement Team works with families, clergy, and the church to:

- Facilitate a Catholic sacramental liturgical celebration for the deceased and their family
- Be servant/leaders for the family during this difficult time
- Provide a witness of Christ to all funeral participants
- Enable and facilitate necessary sacraments for funeral participants
- Welcome and restore funeral participants to the Catholic Church
- Celebrate All Souls' Day
- Assist with funeral pre-planning

Ministry Time Commitment & Needs

Unlike other liturgical ministries, the Bereavement Team operates on an "as-needed" basis. While training sessions are scheduled in advance, Funeral Masses are inherently unplanned and can require rapid coordination. Celebrating a sacramental Funeral Mass relies on the mobilization of a full liturgical team, including Lectors, Eucharistic Ministers, Music Ministers, Hospitality Ministers, Sacristans, Altar Servers, Deacons, and Priests—all of whom comprise the Bereavement Team.

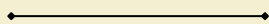
