## MISSION APPEAL: MOST. REV. NIRANJAN SUALSINGH, BISHOP OF SAMBALPUR, INDIA AT ASCENSION 7/19 & 7/20

Sambalpur diocese is in the state of Odisha, one of the poorest States in India. It is in the east of India near to Kolkata. There are 27 parishes with 62,582 Catholics in this vast diocese.

The State of Odisha in India has become synonymous with Christian persecution. The fundamentalist groups have made it their primary field of communal atrocities against minority poor Christians, mostly Tribal and Scheduled Castes. The faithful often face persecution in the name of religion. Amidst these challenges, the mission in Sambalpur is committed to strengthen their faith.

In order to strengthen their faith, we need a chapel in a rural mission where there is no place of worship to have liturgical services. This place could be also used as a place of worship, a place to have faith formation classes for children, and a place of study in the evening hours for children. Most people do not have proper houses and even if they have, they do not have electricity. It will be a multipurpose center in the mission. People are ready to offer land and as well labor to build this proposed center. However, they are very economically poor. Your contribution will help them to make their dream possible. The mission needs your generosity to keep the flame of Christian faith alive.

The Most. Rev. Niranjan Sualsingh, Bishop of Sambalpur, India will be visiting Ascension Parish on 7/19 and 7/20 to ask for your support. We thank and appreciate your generous help and we pray for God's blessings upon you all.
