ASCENSION JUBILEE YEAR 2025 CELEBRATION: MONTH OF OCTOBER 2025

Jubilee Year in the Catholic Church is a special year of grace. The celebration takes its roots from the Scriptures: "You shall count seven weeks of years—seven times seven years—such that the seven weeks of years amount to forty-nine years... You shall treat this fiftieth year as sacred. You shall proclaim liberty in the land for all its inhabitants." (Lev. 25:8-10)



The Vatican office published a short background of the Jubilee year celebration: "In 1300, Pope Boniface VIII called the first Jubilee, also known as a "Holy Year," since it is a time in which God's holiness transforms us. The frequency of Holy Years has changed over time: at first, they were celebrated every 100 years; later, in 1343 Pope Clement VI reduced the gap between Jubilees to every 50 years, and in 1470 Pope Paul II made it every 25 years. There have also been "extraordinary" Holy Years: for example, in 1933 Pope Pius XI chose to commemorate the 1900th anniversary of the Redemption, and in 2015 Pope Francis proclaimed the Year of Mercy as an extraordinary jubilee. The way in which Jubilee Years are marked has also changed through the centuries: originally the Holy Year consisted of a pilgrimage to the Roman Basilicas of St. Peter and St. Paul, later other signs were added, such as the Holy Door. By participating in the Holy Year, one is granted a plenary indulgence."

At Ascension, we will mark the month of October as a month of celebration for the Jubilee Year. We will designate each weekend of October as a special Jubilee for various groups in the parish. Stay tuned.


