CHARACTERISTIC OF THE JUBILEE YEAR: HOLY DOOR

The **Holy Door** is one of the most important symbols of the Jubilee Year. Our journey of hope as pilgrims is aimed at entering the fullness of life with God. On earth, the act of entering the "holy door" is a powerful sign of spiritual renewal and one's desire to enter life with God, our salvation. The holy door took its inspiration from the image of Christ being the "Door" or the "Gate" (cf. John 10). When we pass through the Holy Door, we manifest strongly our desire to be one with God, to live in his presence.



This symbolism finds its fullness when we journey to Rome, the "eternal city", and enter through the Holy Door at the Basilica of St. Peter or the other Roman Basilicas. Those unable to make the pilgrimage to the "eternal city," local dioceses have designated pilgrim churches through which we can make the symbolic pilgrimage and unite ourselves in prayer to God, entering his presence.

The important role of the diocesan pilgrim church and indeed, every local church, is highlighted by the Holy See's Office for the Jubilee Year 2025 in these words: "For the Christian community, a church is not only a sacred space, to be approached with respect, with appropriate behavior and dress code, but it is a symbol of the communion that binds every believer to Christ: it is a place of encounter and dialogue, of reconciliation and peace which awaits every pilgrim, the Church is essentially the place of the community of the faithful." 
