

- You need a valid passport
- Our team of all volunteers will be led by a Project Mercy team lead who has built hundreds of these homes
- Wear clothes that you can get dirty, can work in and spill paint on, and wear hard sole shoes that cover your toes
- Bring plenty of water & drinks (to last you eight hours while working outside), plus lunch with extra snacks
- No skills needed—only a good team attitude and the desire to work




