## JUBILEE OF HOPE: RECONCILIATION & INDULGENCE



Our scheduled parish local pilgrimages have completed. However, one can schedule a personal pilgrimage to our diocesan Jubilee church: the Cathedral of St. Joseph. On this personal pilgrimage, focus on the jubilee sign of reconciliation and indulgence. You may also use the Pilgrimage Prayer posted on our parish website or use the QR code to the right.

Jubilee year is a sign of reconciliation because it establishes a “favorable time” (cf. 2 Corinthians 6:2) for conversion. We are called to put God at the center of our lives, growing toward Him and acknowledging His primacy. Concretely, reconciliation is about experiencing the sacrament of Reconciliation, taking advantage of this time to rediscover the value of confession, and personally receiving God's word of forgiveness. There are some Jubilee churches that continuously offer the possibility for Reconciliation. Indulgence is a concrete manifestation of God's mercy, which surpasses and transforms the boundaries of human justice. This gift of grace came about by Jesus' saving mission. Seeing the witnesses of Jesus and the saints and living in communion with them, our hope for our own forgiveness is strengthened. Concretely, the experience of God's mercy involves some spiritual actions, as Pope Francis has recommended to the faithful. Those who cannot make the Jubilee pilgrimage due to illness or other circumstances are nevertheless invited to take part in the spiritual journey that accompanies this Jubilee year. Among the conditions for receiving the indulgence is praying for the Pope's intentions.

## CHRISTMAS MESSAGE 2025

When we celebrate the joy of Christmas we think of gifts - the gift of family, friends, good health, material blessings, presents, among others. We see colored lights in our homes and neighborhoods, and they elicit some joy in us. It is a wonderful time of the year. In the Gospel of Luke (2:14), the angels proclaimed a message of "great joy" for all people and invited us to sing the glory of God at the birth of our Lord. The source of the joy is the birth of the baby Jesus, our Lord, which is a manifestation of God's peace to people favored by God.

Christ brings "peace to those on whom his favors rest." A variant translation used in the liturgy reads "peace on earth to men who are God's friends." Our part is to receive it and strive to be "friends of God" so we can manifest God's peace in our world.

May we experience deep joy in the birth of Jesus and know his peace. May we extend the peace of Christ to all and transform our troubled world into haven of reconciliation and unity. Merry Christmas!

## IRA REQUIRED MINIMUM DISTRIBUTIONS & STOCK DONATIONS REMINDER

**Parish Closure Note:** The parish office will be closed for the holidays beginning the afternoon of December 24, 2025 through January 1, 2026.

As scripture reads, “Jesus said, ‘Give and it will be given to you... For the measure you give will be in turn, the measure that you get back.’” We thank you for your generous donations and cooperation.

### IRA Required Minimum Distributions Reminder:

Qualified charitable contributions must be made by December 31 each year to exclude that amount from income.

Charitable contributions can only be made from IRAs—not 401(k)s or similar types of retirement accounts. Donors might need to roll funds over from 401(k) to an IRA if they want to make a charitable tax-free contribution to their retirement plan. A donor doesn't need to itemize their taxes in order to make an IRS charitable distribution. Donors should consult with their personal tax advisors on the donations and the tax implications.

### Stock Donations Reminder:

A gift of your securities, including stocks or mutual funds, is an easy way to make a gift. By making a gift of your appreciated securities, you can avoid paying capital gains tax that would otherwise be due if you sold these assets. The deadline for gifting stock and to ensure that your gift is processed for 2025 is December 15, 2025.
