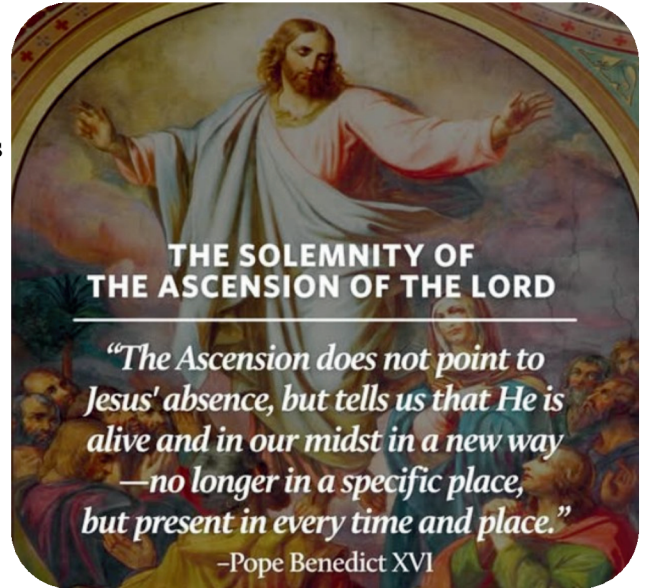
SOLEMNITY OF THE ASCENSION OF THE LORD: MAY 17

The Feast of the Ascension of the Lord, celebrated 40 days after Easter (Sunday observed), commemorates the moment when the risen Christ, in the sight of His apostles, ascended bodily into heaven (Acts 1:9-11).

It marks the completion of His earthly mission and the beginning of His exaltation at the right hand of the Father, where He intercedes for us as our eternal High Priest.

The Ascension is a reminder that heaven is our true home and that Jesus, fully God and fully man, has gone before us to prepare a place for us in the Father's house.

Through His Ascension, Jesus affirms His divine authority and points to our ultimate destiny.



PROCESSION OF OUR LADY OF FATIMA: MAY 17

On May 13, 1917 a young woman clothed in white appeared to three shepherd children in a field near Fátima, Portugal. She asked them to pray the Rosary every day, to do penance for sinners, and to return to that same place on the 13th of each month. She told them her name only at the final apparition: the Lady of the Rosary.

More than a century later, her message has not changed. On May 13, 2026 the Church celebrates the anniversary of the first apparition and invites all Catholics to renew their response to her call. Our Lady of Fátima came with three requests: pray the Rosary, do penance, and consecrate your heart to her Son.



Please meet at the Church front doors after the 5:30 pm Mass on Sunday, May 17 as we sing “Immaculate Mary” and light our candles for our procession in the parking lot. Children are also encouraged to join.
