#### CHARACTERISTIC OF THE JUBILEE YEAR: PRAYER & LITURGY

Prayer is opening oneself to God and experiencing his presence in our lives. This begins with one's desire to open oneself increasingly to God. God wants to walk with us. Do we allow him? The jubilee year is an opportunity for us to realign ourselves so that we allow God to be part of our lives.



A big segment of our pilgrimage needs to be devoted to prayer. Prayer is the instrument in which we devote time not just to appreciate the

beauty of the pilgrim site or churches that we visit but to really sit down, close our eyes and feel the spirit of God that guided pilgrims in the past, saints that passed this way before, to a journey of deep encounter with God. In the experience of those who have achieved a deeper closeness with God, the more we spend time in prayer, the more we long for Him.

Liturgy is the public prayer of the Church: in the words of the Second Vatican Council, it is the "summit toward which the activity of the Church is directed; [and,] at the same time it is the font from which all her power flows." (Sacrosanctum Concilium, 10). At the center of the Christian liturgy is the Mass – the Eucharistic celebration, where the Body and Blood of Christ are truly received. As a pilgrim, Christ himself walks alongside the disciples and reveals to them the mysteries of the Father, so that they too can say, like the disciples on the road to Emmaus, "Stay with us, for it is nearly evening and the day is almost over." #### STANDING WITH IMMIGRANTS & REFUGEES

Migrants in San Diego and across the nation are facing their scheduled court appointments with heighted fear. This is especially true when they are approaching the courthouse as part of their due process rights.

Under the leadership of Bishop Michael Pham, the Diocese of San Diego has instituted a process for the accompaniment of migrants to their hearings at the court house. Guided by their faith, clergy, other representatives from religious groups, and Catholic laypersons offer their presence, comfort, and prayer to create a more secure and peaceful means to secure the rights of immigrants and refugees to a fair hearing of their cases. This Ministry is called **Faithful Court Accompaniment -- Faithful Accompaniment in Trust and Hope**.

Your MOC Team is encouraging the creation of a team of trained parishioners to participate with concerned Catholics and others in this ministry. Two of our parishioners are already trained: Jean Kerr and Carmela Cavero. Please consider joining this effort to show migrants they are not alone as they navigate the complex legal system.
