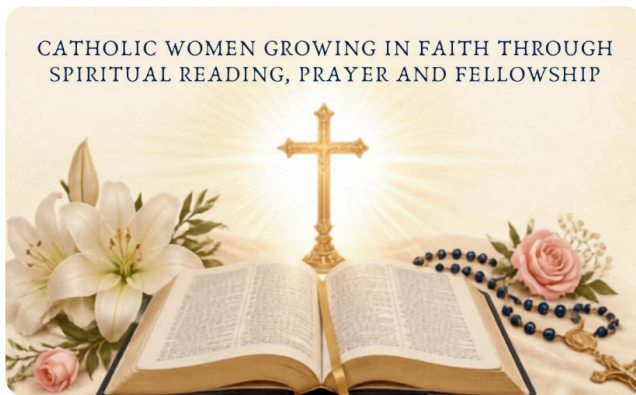

MINISTRY HIGHLIGHT: CARING FOR THE WHOLE PERSON

Ministry Overview

Have you ever come to Church and realized that you haven't seen someone you know, and the last time was a few weeks or a month ago? Then later, you walk into the vestibule and see their picture announcing the date of their Funeral Mass. You had no idea what was happening. You wish you could have responded in some way—a visit, a phone call just to let them know they have been missed, or perhaps a prayer.

Caring for the Whole Person (CWP) is an initiative of the Bishops of California, Oregon and Washington. This pro-life initiative was meant to promote the dignity of the human person in difficult, acute, and chronic healthcare situations—especially at the end of life. The initiative began in the Diocese of San Diego in 2019, with calls for parish programs to be established in parishes with the support of diocesan personnel and resources. Ascension Parish established this ministry in 2020.

CWP is a ministry that identifies parishioners in our parish who are vulnerable, who may be alone and may be suffering with acute or chronic illness, or who may need support and consolation. Our goal is to accompany them during their journey through these difficulties.

With their consent and encouraged family participation, our CWP Ministers visit as needed in a ministry that is primarily of presence, listening, prayer, and support. CWP suggests available resources only as requested, and bring the community of the parish to them because they may not be able to participate in parish activities as they might like or have in the past.

Caring for the Whole Person is an especially meaningful ministry for our senior parishioners. Many of them have been active in our parish for many years (perhaps as ministers themselves or have volunteered at Fiesta, for example) or have attended our weekend or weekday Holy Masses for many years. Suddenly, they can find themselves feeling isolated and cut off from parish life due to medical or physical conditions. CWP allows them to continue to feel connected to their Ascension community.

Ministry Time Commitment & Needs

Our team of CWP Ministers currently visit many of our parishioners who are in the above situations. In the event of an end-of-life journey, hopefully ministers are already there offering prayer, friendship, and support. CWP Ministers can bring bulletins, add their wishes into the Book of Needs, or add their name for prayers in the parish bulletin. If requested, ministers can bring the Holy Eucharist or arrange Pastoral care when needed. Visits to parishioners are scheduled on an as-needed basis, arranged between the parishioner and the CWP Minister.
