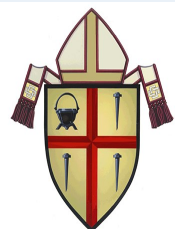

Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion

(*Confirmed Catholic, any age*): Distribute the Precious Body and Blood of Christ during the Mass. Training is provided to ensure proper care and reverence of the Eucharist is shown. **Training will be on Mon., Aug. 7th at 7:00 p.m. at the Parish church.**

Great need at 4:30 p.m., 11:00 am and 5:30 p.m. Masses

Minister of Hospitality

(*Elementary School accompanied by adult — Adult*): Extend hospitality to all throughout the worship experience. This includes greeting at church doors, distributing liturgical resources, assisting with seating, taking the collections, ushering Holy Communion and dismissing. Leadership role of Captain is available. **Training will be done 30 mins. before any scheduled Mass.**

Altar Servers

(*Grade 4 — Adult*): Assist presider with service to the altar; including processing with the Cross or Torches, carrying the presider texts and setting the altar for Holy Communion. **Training will be done 30 mins. before any scheduled Mass.**

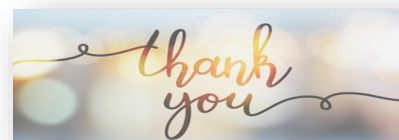

Hopefully we can all take the time to relax at some point and allow the grace of this season to fill us with all that we need. Your Ministries of Charity are planning many opportunities for service to the poor this year. Details of some of those plans are contained in this update. RACHEL'S HOUSE DINNER SERVICE:

Our Rachel's Dinner Service is back. *Ann Galbraith* is the MOC leader heading up this service. The scheduled dates for this year are Aug 2nd, Sept 6th, Oct 10th, and Dec 6th

Ann could use a few volunteers to help her with these dinners.

This service prepares, delivers, and serves dinners for approximately 25 to 40 homeless women who use Rachel's Day Center and Night Shelter downtown with the support of your Ministries of Charity. We provide a nourishing dinner and a safe place for these women to eat their meals. The meals are prepared, transported to the Rachel's Center, and served by our parishioners. **Ann could use a few volunteers to help with this service. HOUSEWARMING FOR THE HOMELESS:

This weekend MOC is launching their summer initiative called "Housewarming for the Homeless." Please join us in helping FJV in its efforts of helping the homeless off the streets of San Diego. This weekend, July 22/23, we will supply two options for you to help. We will supply either a basket or a small storage bin with directions to purchase **(new only)** items, either the bed & bath or the kitchen. A list of items and directions for this MOC project is attached to each collection container. The cost of the items is \$70 or less. There are suggestions about where to get these items and their approximate cost.

Please pick up a basket or bin at the MOC booth after mass to the Right of the Main door this weekend. You can purchase these items yourself or share the effort with another family. The date to return your baskets & bins to the MOC booth after each Mass or to the office during the week. Thank you for helping Father Joe's Villages serve the homeless. Father Joe's Villages maintains several resident buildings to house the homeless as they receive services to move individuals and families off the streets. The turnover of residents is constant and FJV is always in need of houseware items to accommodate and supply the new residents with new household items.
