

MINISTRIES OF CHARITY UPDATE #2023 – 22

December 14th, 2023

Dear Friends in Christ,

MOC is now moving into its winter schedule of events. Please join us as we continue to serve those in need. You can read about all of our activities in the parish bulletin, on the parish website, and in this update. Here is your next MOC Update #2023 -22.

HELP FOR THE HOMELESS:

Our first MOC 2024 event will be "Help for the Homeless", a project to serve the Homeless in San Diego. This event will be two separate, simultaneous projects. The first project will benefit the children from the Department of Children and Youth in Transition (CYT), within the San Diego City School District. This little known department serves all children within the school system who are living in transitional situations. This includes children who are homeless, or in transitional housing, i.e. military and immigrant families in need. Children from these situations are regularly in crisis and are served by CYT with school supplies, clothes and food. What is their most critical need? Believe it or not, children's underwear. Many, many of these children do not have new or clean underwear. CYT's closets are empty. Please help, we will be accepting donations, throughout January, of new children's underwear: Kindergarten to 12th grade, boy's, and girl's, all sizes. Help us send these children to school completely dressed.

The second project, will be a collection of shoes (new or gently used) and socks for the homeless. We will be having a distribution of these and other items, as well as, serving a meal at Catholic Charities' Neil Good Center on Feb 10, 2024. Collections for all these items will begin in January 2024. There will be donation bins in the vestibule of the Church. Clean out your closets and fill our bins. We will be having a signup table to help with the distribution and meal service outside of church after weekend masses the 2nd and 3rd weekends in January. More news to come!
