

Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion

(*Confirmed Catholic, any age*): Distribute the Precious Body and Blood of Christ during the Mass. Training is provided to ensure proper care and reverence of the Eucharist is shown. **Training will be on Mon., Aug. 7th at 7:00 p.m. at the Parish church.**

Minister of Hospitality

(*Elementary School accompanied by adult — Adult*): Extend hospitality to all throughout the worship experience. This includes greeting at church doors, distributing liturgical resources, assisting with seating, taking the collections, ushering Holy Communion and dismissing. Leadership role of Captain is available. **Training will be done 30 mins. before any scheduled Mass.**

Re: Ascension Mission Appeal for Kabale Diocese-Uganda (July 29/30 2023)

Kabale Diocese Profile

Kabale Diocese is one of the 19 dioceses in Uganda located in the southwestern corner of the country—about 280 miles from the capital city of Kampala. We serve a population of about 1.8 million people, and 800, 000 are Roman Catholic. The vast majority of the people we serve are located in rural, under-served, and mostly remote areas of the country. Most critical among the challenges they face is healthcare. Leading causes of death in Uganda include neonatal disorders, HIV/AIDS, tuberculosis, malaria, lower respiratory infections, diarrheal diseases, congenital defects, heart disease, stroke, road injury, and malnutrition.

Purpose of the appeal

The purpose of my request is to seek financial support toward the development of a hospital for the rural poor—Our Lady of Good Health Hospital Rushoroza. Through the gracious generosity of many, we have managed to complete the initial phase--outpatient department, minor operating room, medical/ surgical ward and small delivery/maternity unit. We are transitioning into the next phase for which we are seeking assistance, a phase that comprises of children's ward, dental, ophthalmology, radiology, medical laboratory units, and expansion on emergency room, operating room, maternity unit, and ambulance services. Our one and only ambulance is 16 years old and almost beyond repair.

We are also seeking assistance to support our long-term Kabale Diocese Orphaned and Vulnerable Children Program. Through our foster home care program, we provide out-reach support to orphaned children the vast majority of whom have lost both parents and are left all alone to fend for themselves. We provide them with shelter, school tuition, clothing, and healthcare. We are currently supporting 540 children out of well over 20,000 greatly in need of help.

Additionally, although we are eternally grateful for the gift of vocations, currently 78 major seminarians and 820 catechists, we face a mounting challenge of their training and formation costs--\$400/year for one seminarian, and 150 for one catechist in training.

Any measure of outreach help will be greatly appreciated.

Minimum age is 10 y/o.

RACHEL'S HOUSE DINNER SERVICE:

Our Rachel's Dinner Service is back on line. Ann Galbraith is the MOC leader heading up this service. The scheduled dates for this year are Aug 2nd, Sept 6th, Oct 10th, and Dec 6th.

Ann could use a few volunteers to help her with these dinners.

This service prepares, delivers, and serves dinners for approximately 25 to 40 homeless woman who use Rachel's Day Center and Night Shelter downtown with the support of your Ministries of Charity. We provide a nourishing dinner and a safe place for these women to eat their meals. The meals are prepared, transported to the Rachel's Center, and served by our parishioners.
