


#### ASCENSION PARISH PASTORAL COUNCIL NEEDS NEW MEMBERS

The Pastoral Council assists the pastor in the administration of the pastoral aspects of parish life, including all ministries and parish activities and events. The responsibilities of members include but are not limited to engaging parishioners in the spiritual and pastoral life of the parish; collaborating with the pastor in providing direction and oversight for all pastoral aspects of parish life; reviewing the pastoral policies of the diocese for parish implementation; and establishing pastoral priorities with goals and objectives.

The body holds bimonthly meetings typically in July, September, November, January. Members include both parish staff and parishioners. Five new members will be elected or appointed this July. Four members will serve the full term for four years (2023-2027) and one appointed member will serve for 2 years until 2025. The election will be on July 15-16, 2023.

Deadline for nomination will be the July 1-2 weekend.

## **MOC UPDATE**

#### SAINT VINCENT DE PAUL DINNER SERVICE:

Our St. Vincent De Paul Dinner Service scheduled for the whole year. New revamped safety/health procedures now in place, so the volunteer team size needed is smaller (only one Lead and 6 volunteers per dinner service).

We have four (4) scheduled dinner service events left for 2023. The dates are August 12<sup>th</sup>, October 14<sup>th</sup>, and December 2<sup>nd</sup>.

We are looking for leaders and volunteers for these remaining dates. You can still volunteer for the last three dates of the year. It is easy to be a volunteer and to be a leader for one of these dinner groups. Please consider leading one.

To volunteer, please sign-up on the parish website. You must also register as a volunteer on the St. Vincent de Paul website. Please consider joining one of these teams. If you have teens, it is also a very good family service project. Minimum age is 10 y/o.

Our next open St. Dinner Service is on Saturday August 12<sup>th</sup>.

#### **RACHEL'S HOUSE DINNER SERVICE:**

Our Rachel's Dinner Service is back on line. Ann Galbraith is the MOC leader heading up this service. The scheduled dates for this year are Aug 2<sup>nd</sup>, Sept 6<sup>th</sup>, Oct 10<sup>th</sup>, and Dec 6<sup>th</sup>. **Ann could use a few volunteers to help her with these dinners.** 

This service prepares, delivers, and serves dinners for approximately 25 to 40 homeless woman who use Rachel's Day Center and Night Shelter downtown with the support of your Ministries of Charity. We provide a nourishing dinner and a safe place for these women to eat their meals. The meals are prepared, transported to the Rachel's Center, and served by our parishioners.
