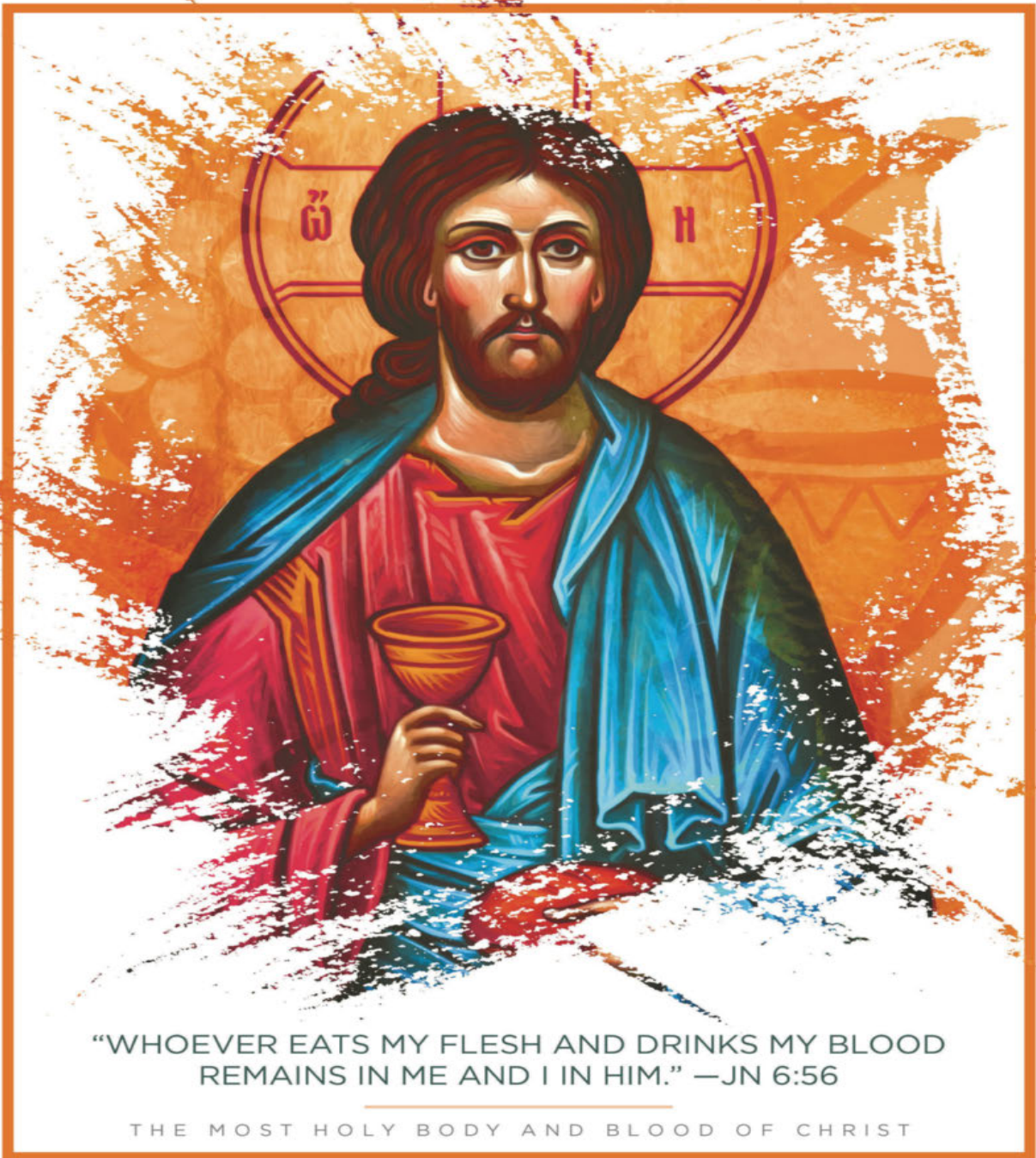

ASCENSION PARISH PASTORAL COUNCIL NEEDS NEW MEMBERS

The Pastoral Council assists the pastor in the administration of the pastoral aspects of parish life, including all ministries and parish activities and events. The responsibilities of members include but are not limited to engaging parishioners in the spiritual and pastoral life of the parish; collaborating with the pastor in providing direction and oversight for all pastoral aspects of parish life; reviewing the pastoral policies of the diocese for parish implementation; and establishing pastoral priorities with goals and objectives.

The body holds bimonthly meetings typically in July, September, November, January. Members include both parish staff and parishioners. Five new members will be elected or appointed this July. Four members will serve the full term for four years (2023-2027) and one appointed member will serve for 2 years until 2025. The election will be on July 15-16, 2023. Deadline for nomination will be the July 1-2 weekend.

ASCENSION IS LOOKING FOR A BOOKKEEPER!

The bookkeeper position provides support the pastor and the finance council in maintaining and regulating our parish financial health. It is a part-time, non-exempt position. The normal schedule is 19-25 hours per week. Hours typically will be worked on Mondays, Tuesdays, and other days.

Primary duties and responsibilities include:

Financial: Maintain financial bookkeeping system including accounts payable, receivable, and cash receipts; Balance accounts, ledgers and reconciles bank statements; Pay bills, make bank deposits, and process credit card payments; Send donor acknowledgments and statement of contribution/donation for tax purposes; Update bulletin with weekly income and with the assistance of finance council post quarterly financial statement; Prepare monthly financial statements for pastor, the finance council and the diocese finance office; Verify employee timesheets and process payroll on a bi-weekly basis; Oversee inventory of parish supplies; Assist in preparing the parish annual budget; Prepares depreciation and capitalization schedules for fixed assets, development in progress, property tax schedules and claims for property tax exemptions, compilation of sales tax to State Board of Equalization; Provides other administrative collateral functions as directed by the pastor.

General Administrative: Maintain parish inventory system; Collaborate with diocese on financial matters; Serve as liaison between the parish and diocesan Human Resources for staff related matters; Attend diocesan bookkeepers' meetings and webinars.

Position Requirements:

Practicing knowledge of accounting, record keeping, and budgeting principles and practices; Ability to work collaboratively with pastor, staff, and volunteers; College graduate and/or training equivalent; Two to Five years experience in office administration, preferably in a financial capacity; MS Office software experience required; Two years experience with Quickbooks software.

ASCENSION IS LOOKING FOR AN OFFICE ADMINISTRATIVE ASSISTANT!

The administrative assistant position provides support to the Parish Office. The position is non-exempt, part-time, 28 hours, Monday to Wednesday (8:00a.m. to 4:00p.m.) and Thursday (12:00pm to 4:00p.m.)

Primary duties and responsibilities include:

Answer and manage incoming calls. Take accurate messages; Greet visitors and assist as appropriate Process outgoing and incoming mail; Word processing of letters, reports and memos; mail, copy, collate materials and filing as needed; Prepare weekly bulletin; Oversee inventory of office supplies; Schedule events and meetings; Mass intentions; weddings and funerals as requested and collect appropriate donation. Issue and monitor keys; Maintain parish offering envelope system; Provide a variety of other clerical services such as data entry, file maintenance, and photocopying; Other duties as assigned.

Education and Experience:

3 years of prior administrative assistant experience preferred; strong MS Office skills (Word, Excel, Publisher, etc); Familiar with the organizational structure and practices of the Roman Catholic Church.

Knowledge and Skills:

Must possess strong writing/proofreading skills; Reliable, organized, self-motivated, and punctual Possess positive attitude with good interpersonal skills; Good communication skills with strong attention to detail; Must be able to maintain a high degree of confidentiality.

ASCENSION IS LOOKING FOR A COORDINATOR OF RELIGIOUS EDUCATION!

R.E. Coordinator is responsible for the coordination and organization of the parish religious education program at the elementary and junior high levels for the children attending public school. It is a part-time, non-exempt position. The normal schedule is 19-25 hours per week. Hours typically will be worked on Sundays, Mondays, and Tuesdays.

Primary duties and responsibilities include:

- To create, implement, and evaluate the “goals and objectives” of the Religious Education program (elementary and junior high [gr 5-6]);
- To assure the selection of appropriate catechetical texts and materials according to diocesan guidelines;
- To recruit, prepare and train volunteer catechists for each grade level;
- To prepare and assist catechists in their role of teacher as a resource of experience and knowledge;
- To coordinate with other members of the parish staff and attend regular weekly staff meetings;
- To develop and implement an RCIC program with the Coordinator of Youth Ministries for children 8 and above who need to receive the sacraments of initiation;
- To prepare and implement Children’s Liturgy of the Word for children in K-5 during the 11:00 A.M. Sunday Mass; and prepare and implement a Vacation Bible School program in the month of June;
- To initiate program and activities appropriate for creative program (i.e. Family Day, Family Suppers, etc.);
- To organize and conduct registration (in coordination with parish secretary), parent meetings, and sacramental information meetings in conjunction with the religious education and parish calendar;
- To coordinate and inform parents of Religious Education calendar of events for all grade levels;
- To prepare and implement special liturgies for children of religious education and for the catechist team;
- To attend pastoral council meetings and act as liaison with parish religious education team and with the parish pastoral council;
- To maintain close communication with the Diocesan Office for Evangelization and Catechetical Ministry;

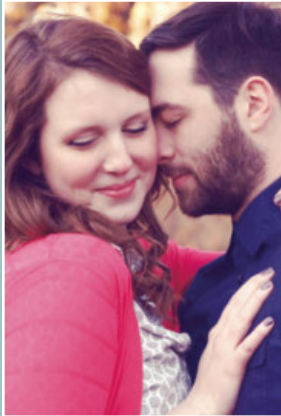


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
