




ASCENSION PARISH PASTORAL COUNCIL NEEDS NEW MEMBERS

The Pastoral Council assists the pastor in the administration of the pastoral aspects of parish life, including all ministries and parish activities and events. The responsibilities of members include but are not limited to engaging parishioners in the spiritual and pastoral life of the parish; collaborating with the pastor in providing direction and oversight for all pastoral aspects of parish life; reviewing the pastoral policies of the diocese for parish implementation; and establishing pastoral priorities with goals and objectives.

The body holds bimonthly meetings typically in July, September, November, January. Members include both parish staff and parishioners. Five new members will be elected or appointed this July. Four members will serve the full term for four years (2023-2027) and one appointed member will serve for 2 years until 2025. The election will be on July 15-16, 2023.

Deadline for nomination will be the July 1-2 weekend.

ASCENSION IS LOOKING FOR A COORDINATOR OF RELIGIOUS EDUCATION!

R.E. Coordinator is responsible for the coordination and organization of the parish religious education program at the elementary and junior high levels for the children attending public school. It is a part-time, non-exempt position. The normal schedule is 19-25 hours per week. Hours typically will be worked on Sundays, Mondays, and Tuesdays.

Primary duties and responsibilities include:

To create, implement, and evaluate the "goals and objectives" of the Religious Education program (elementary and junior high [gr 5-6]);

To assure the selection of appropriate catechetical texts and materials according to diocesan guidelines; To recruit, prepare and train volunteer catechists for each grade level;

To prepare and assist catechists in their role of teacher as a resource of experience and knowledge;

To coordinate with other members of the parish staff and attend regular weekly staff meetings;

To develop and implement an RCIC program with the Coordinator of Youth Ministries for children 8 and above who need to receive the sacraments of initiation;

To prepare and implement Children's Liturgy of the Word for children in K-5 during the 11:00 A.M. Sunday Mass; and prepare and implement a Vacation Bible School program in the month of June;

To initiate program and activities appropriate for creative program (i.e. Family Day, Family Suppers, etc.);

To organize and conduct registration (in coordination with parish secretary), parent meetings, and sacramental information meetings in conjunction with the religious education and parish calendar;


To coordinate and inform parents of Religious Education calendar of events for all grade levels;

To prepare and implement special liturgies for children of religious education and for the catechist team; To attend pastoral council meetings and act as liaison with parish religious education team and with the parish pastoral council;



How it Works



Sound Source to Amplifier

A sound source, such as a microphone, public address system, or TV feeds an audio signal into a hearing loop amplifier.

Amplifier to Wire Loop

The **amplifier** sends an electric current to one or multiple **wire loops**, which surround the room or seating areas.

Wire Loop to Magnetic Field

The current generates a magnetic field that emanates from the wire loop into the room.

Magnetic Field to Telecoil

Tiny wire coils, known as **telecoils or t-coils**, are built into most hearing aids and all cochlear implants. The telecoil picks up the magnetic signal and turns it back into an electric signal for the device to process.

Telecoil to Customized Audio

A hearing aid, cochlear implant, OTOjOY LoopBuds, or hearing loop receiver converts the signal back into audible sound that is customized for the unique needs and preferences of the listener.

4 Ways to Connect to a Hearing Loop System

Note: If you have a hearing aid without a T-coil switch, speak to your doctor or audiologist and they can advise on a T-coil enabled hearing aid that works best for you.
