

ASCENSION PARISH PASTORAL COUNCIL NEEDS NEW MEMBERS

The Pastoral Council assists the pastor in the administration of the pastoral aspects of parish life, including all ministries and parish activities and events. The responsibilities of members include but are not limited to engaging parishioners in the spiritual and pastoral life of the parish; collaborating with the pastor in providing direction and oversight for all pastoral aspects of parish life; reviewing the pastoral policies of the diocese for parish implementation; and establishing pastoral priorities with goals and objectives.

The body holds bimonthly meetings typically in July, September, November, January. Members include both parish staff and parishioners. Five new members will be elected or appointed this July. Four members will serve the full term for four years (2023-2027) and one appointed member will serve for 2 years until 2025. The election will be on July 15-16, 2023.

Deadline for nomination will be the July 1-2 weekend.

Talk Title: "Seven Mysteries of the Faith Unlocked by the Eucharist"

About the Talk: Instead of treating the Eucharist as just one more doctrine amongst many, Joe shows in this talk how a right understanding of the Eucharist is key for understanding (1) the New Covenant; (2) the Old Covenant; (3) the Mass; (4) Early Christianity; (5) the Church; (6) the lives of the Saints; and (7) your own spiritual life.

About our Speaker: Kansas City native Joe Heschmeyer is a staff apologist for Catholic Answers. A popular author, speaker, blogger, and podcaster, he joined Catholic Answers in March 2021. This service prepares, delivers, and serves dinners for approximately 25 to 40 homeless woman who use Rachel's Day Center and Night Shelter downtown with the support of your Ministries of Charity. We provide a nourishing dinner and a safe place for these women to eat their meals. The meals are prepared, transported to the Rachel's Center, and served by our parishioners.
