WITH A NEW CHURCH COMES OPPORTUNITIES TO UPDATE OUR LITURGICAL PRACTICES.

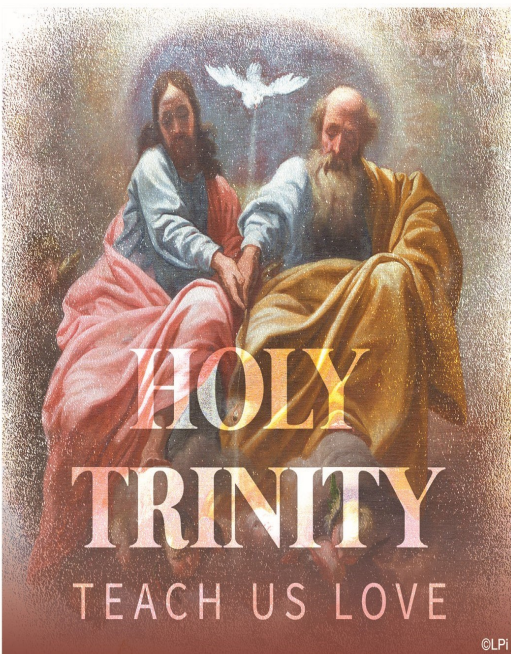
Our new practices include:

Encourage Deeper Understanding of Scripture

In my experience, one of the peculiarities of being a man is the somewhat unlikely ability to look into the mirror, no matter how out of shape he may be, and declare with full confidence: "Looking good, buddy!" Ask a man. He'll probably confirm it.

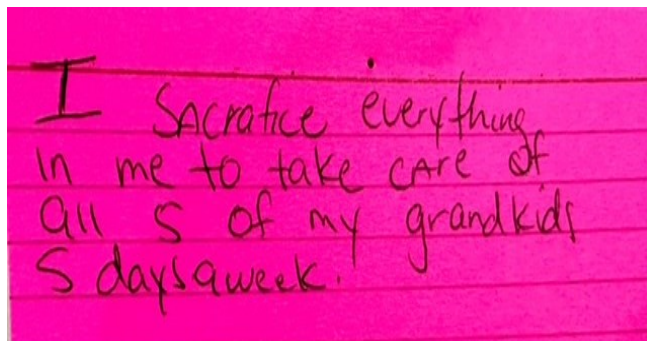
Therein lies a mystery. You might think I refer to man's ability to deceive himself or his propensity toward vainglory. But in this case, I refer to the mystery of a healthy and proper sense of self-love. We human beings (both men and women) have the utterly weird ability to look at ourselves as if we were another. Then we tend to love this "other." Then, somehow, that love becomes a bond between the two. We are three and yet one.

This Sunday is Trinity Sunday. We ponder anew that God in His unity is a play of multiplicity: Lover, Beloved, and shared Love. Or, as we also proclaim, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. If we allow it, this mystery heals our temptation toward self-hatred and destruction. We all know how awful it is to look into the mirror and not know the person we see, or, equally bad, to know and hate who we see. Jesus, the Son of God, draws us into the dynamics of authentic self-knowledge and self-love. Perhaps we could ask the Holy Trinity this Sunday to teach us to truly look at ourselves and to properly love who we see looking back.

ASCENSION IS LOOKING FOR A BOOKKEEPER!

The bookkeeper position provides support the pastor and the finance council in maintaining and regulating our parish financial health. It is a part-time, non-exempt position. The normal schedule is 19-25 hours per week. Hours typically will be worked on Mondays, Tuesdays, and other days.

Primary duties and responsibilities include:

Financial: Maintain financial bookkeeping system including accounts payable, receivable, and cash receipts; Balance accounts, ledgers and reconciles bank statements; Pay bills, make bank deposits, and process credit card payments; Send donor acknowledgments and statement of contribution/donation for tax purposes; Update bulletin with weekly income and with the assistance of finance council post quarterly financial statement; Prepare monthly financial statements for pastor, the finance council and the diocese finance office; Verify employee timesheets and process payroll on a bi-weekly basis; Oversee inventory of parish supplies; Assist in preparing the parish annual budget; Prepares depreciation and capitalization schedules for fixed assets, development in progress, property tax schedules and claims for property tax exemptions, compilation of sales tax to State Board of Equalization; Provides other administrative collateral functions as directed by the pastor.

General Administrative: Maintain parish inventory system; Collaborate with diocese on financial matters; Serve as liaison between the parish and diocesan Human Resources for staff related matters; Attend diocesan bookkeepers' meetings and webinars.

Position Requirements:

Practicing knowledge of accounting, record keeping, and budgeting principles and practices; Ability to work collaboratively with pastor, staff, and volunteers; College graduate and/or training equivalent; Two to Five years experience in office administration, preferably in a financial capacity; MS Office software experience required; Two years experience with Quickbooks software.

Take accurate messages; Greet visitors and assist as appropriate Process outgoing and incoming mail; Word processing of letters, reports and memos; mail, copy, collate materials and filing as needed; Prepare weekly bulletin; Oversee inventory of office supplies; Schedule events and meetings; Mass intentions; weddings and funerals as requested and collect appropriate donation. Issue and monitor keys; Maintain parish offering envelope system; Provide a variety of other clerical services such as data entry, file maintenance, and photocopying; Other duties as assigned.

This month we are trying something different. We will meet Saturday, June 17th at 6:00 at 4183 Pallon Ct for a year end potluck.

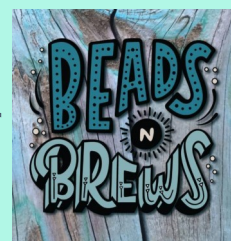

MOC UPDATE

SAINT VINCENT DE PAUL DINNER SERVICE: We have decided to restart our St. Vincent De Paul Dinner Service in 2023. New revamped safety/health procedures now in place, so the volunteer team size needed is smaller (only one Lead and 6 volunteers per dinner service).

We have three (3) scheduled dinner service events left for 2023. The dates are August 12th, October 14th, and December 2nd. **To volunteer, please sign-up on the parish website.** You must also register as a volunteer on the St. Vincent de Paul website. Please consider joining one of these teams. If you have teens, it is also a very good family service project. Minimum age is 10 y/o. **Our next St. Dinner Service is on Saturday June 17, and all volunteer spots are filled.**

RACHEL'S HOUSE DINNER SERVICE: Our Rachel's Dinner Service is back on line. Ann Galbraith is the MOC leader heading up this service. The scheduled dates for this year are June 21st, Aug 2nd, Sept 6th, Oct 10th, and Dec 6th.

This service prepares, delivers, and serves dinners for approximately 25 to 40 homeless woman who use Rachel's Day Center and Night Shelter downtown with the support of your Ministries of Charity. We provide a nourishing dinner and a safe place for these women to eat their meals. The meals are prepared, transported to the Rachel's Center, and served by our parishioners.
