RACHEL'S SHELTER DINNER SERVICE:

Rachel Shelter is located downtown near the Father Joe's facilities. It is operated by the Diocese and provides supportive, safe, short- and mid-term shelter for 35 women. Rachel's requests the help of local parishes to provide dinners for these women, and our last scheduled date is Dec 6th.
