"Pianist, composer, & operatic tenor Phillip Dannels

Phillip is in demand as both a soloist & collaborative artist

A frequent piano recitalist, he has been heard throughout the United States, and has performed as a soloist at Copley Symphony Hall in San Diego in masterclass with renowned pianist Lang Lang.

A composer himself, Dannels advocates for the performance of new works. Particularly treasured is his multi-year relationship with the Del Mar International Composer's Symposium, where he has participated as a collaborative pianist in the performance of several modern operas and song cycles, including world premieres.

On the opera stage, Dannels has performed under the auspices of the San Diego Opera, Bodhi Tree Concerts, and Point Loma Opera Theatre. Highlights include the Father in Seven Deadly Sins (Weill), the Young Gypsy in Aleko (Rachmaninov), and Danilo in Die lustige Witwe (Lehar). As an oratorio singer, he has performed soloist roles in Elijah (Mendelssohn), the Messiah (Händel), and the Creation (Haydn), all with Point Loma Nazarene University's Choral Union.

He spent several seasons as the assistant conductor for Point Loma Opera Theatre, working on their productions of Massenet's Cendrillon and Loesser's The Most Happy Fella. He also staged and directed their production of Donizetti's Rita. He has served as a répétiteur and coach for various operas, operettas, & musicals throughout the San Diego area.

Religious Education Director, Abby Gonzalez

Abby is originally from Watts in Los Angeles. Thanks to the generosity of scholarships for low-income families, she was able to attend Catholic school from 1st grade to college. The first in her family to attend university. Abby graduated from Mount St. Mary's University with degrees in Nursing and Sociology. Abby joined the Navy shortly after and served for 8 years as a Navy Nurse. Her husband Adolfo is still an Active-Duty Command Master Chief and their assignments have moved them from CA to VA to TX and back to CA. Abby and Adolfo have 3 awesome children. Ethan 19, David 10 and Isabel 7.

Abby has served in different capacities in parish life, but the most recent has been catechist. "For me, learning more about God and His church has allowed me to know him more. Knowing him more has allowed me to build a closer relationship with him as well as being more in Communion with our church community. This is the exact reason why I took this job! I would like to teach our parish families and children more about our Faith. In truly understanding what we believe and why we believe it, I hope that they will build a closer relationship with Jesus, our Father, and the Holy Spirit."

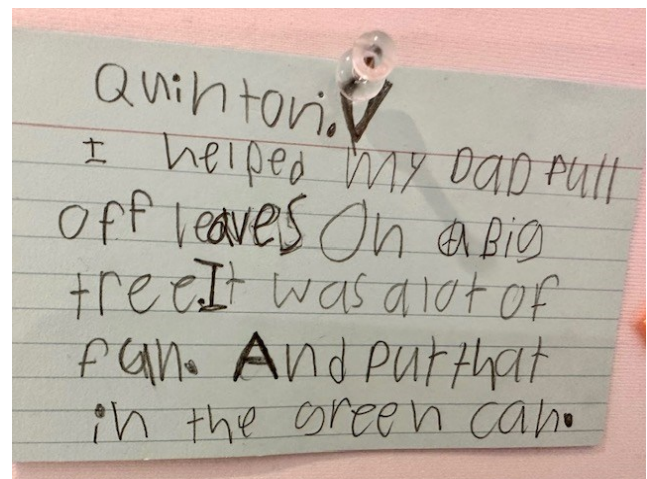
