Itinerary

Day 1: Cheerio it's off to London! Board your motorcoach transportation in N. Londonderry to Boston Logan Airport for our direct overnight flight to London.

Day 2: Arrival early morning to Heathrow airport, transfer over to Windsor, where we enjoy a wholesome breakfast as well as a meet & greet with our guide. Afterwards a visit to the famous weekend residence of the royal family, **Windsor Castle.** We'll tour around one of the world's largest and longest occupied castles and discover the secrets enveloped over its thousand-year history along with a visit to **Windsor's Christmas Market**. Later in the afternoon we'll depart Windsor and head north towards the town of *Oxford*, check in at our hotel for some rest and relaxation. In the evening we enjoy a lovely get together dinner with wine. Overnight in Oxford

Day 3: After a hearty breakfast we enjoy some free time to walk around the town that is home to one of the most renowned and prestigious universities in the world. We walk through the historic buildings of Oxford University where the walls breathe centuries of knowledge and have been the inspiration for countless leaps in humanity, as well as inspiration for JK Rowling's Harry Potter series. Free time for lunch in the late afternoon. Afterwards, we'll head north, to enjoy the Christmas markets and lights of the infamous Blenheim Palace. A Palace with countless stories to tell, Blenheim Palace is most well known for being the ancestral home of Winston Churchill. Today, the palace welcomes visitors and, in the weeks, leading up to Christmas, is renowned for having one of the most colorful and festive markets in all of England. Return late in the evening to our hotel. Overnight in Oxford

Day 4: In the morning we'll leave Oxford and head west towards the meadows and fields of the Cotswolds, officially named an area of outstanding beauty, the Cotswolds are renowned for their quintessential English villages, brimming with honey colored stone houses. We'll tour around some of these pretty villages with plenty of photo stops along the way. Arriving late afternoon in the historic town of Bath. Free afternoon to enjoy the delights of Bath and the Bath Christmas Market, where we spend our next two night's. Overnight stay in Bath

Day 5: In the morning we'll enjoy a tour around the elegant streets of Bath. Famous for almost two thousand years since the time of the Romans for its thermal waters and a place of escape and relaxation even for today's Brits. We visit the Roman baths, where we discover the importance of the town's waters followed by a chance to enjoy some afternoon tea in one of Bath's refined establishments. Afterwards, a free afternoon to enjoy one of the many delightful spas and relaxing places the town has to offer and of course the colorful Bath Christmas market, a few doors away from our hotel.





Day 6: Departing Bath in the morning, we'll head west across the rolling green fields of the English countryside. Stop and tour a cider farm where we learn how one of England's best drinks is produced along with some delicious straight from the barrel cider tasting. After which, we continue to journey across the fields and meadows of England and arrive at Stonehenge. One of the most marvelous structures ever to be still in existence since the dawn of humanity. We'll enjoy a guided tour around and discover the history of these enchanting stone circles. Later in the afternoon we head further south, towards the county of Hampshire, home to beautiful rolling hills, Tudor houses and birthplace of the famous Pride and Prejudice author Jane Austin. We'll stay overnight in the medieval town of Winchester with our hotel being a short walk away from Winchester's grand cathedral and Christmas Market.

In the late afternoon, we'll depart for Britain's infamous capital, London. Our home for the next 3 nights. Overnight in the Maldron Finsbury Park.

Day 8: Today we'll begin our guided tour of London with a visit to Westminster Abbey and Big Ben. Afterwards, we'll enjoy some free time shopping in one of the world's most famous and luxurious department stores, Harrods. Late afternoon we'll enjoy the festive scenes on the grounds of Hyde Park's Winter Wonderland Christmas Park. Free evening to enjoy Finsbury Park and our hotel's surroundings.

After uncovering the Tower of London, it's time for some food and shopping. We'll have free time to enjoy the gourmet delights of Fortnum and Mason's. One of London's best known department stores that's renowned for its luxury food products. Free time to enjoy the delights of this foodie's paradise. In the evening we'll have a final get together with dinner and wine at our hotel.

Day 10: Time to say goodbye. After our incredible journey across the rolling hills and great towns, it's time to say goodbye to Britannia. Knowing when we come back home that this majestic land will always welcome us back with open arms. Breakfast and transfer back to Heathrow airport.
