

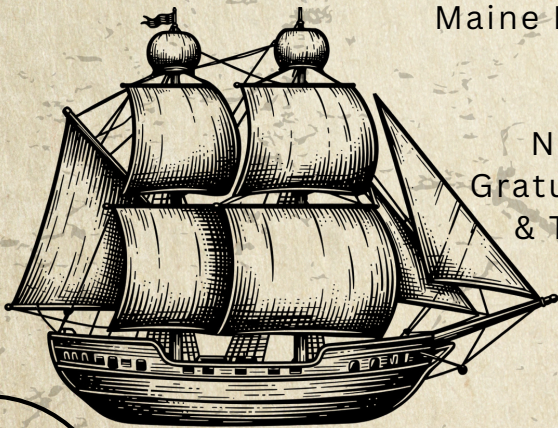

Today board the Merrymeeting for an up-close look at some of Maine's Iconic Lighthouses and abundant wildlife. You'll hear about Maine's seafaring history on the banks of the Kennebec River as you get an up-close look at Navy vessels under construction at Bath Iron Works. After the cruise, experience the Maine Maritime Museum. Once known as P&S Shipyard this is the ONLY intact shipyard site in the United States that built large wooden sailing vessels. This 20-acre waterfront campus includes indoor galleries with rotating & permanent exhibits. The museum's working Boat shop keeps Maine's wooden boatbuilding traditions alive!
