Suggested itinerary

Day 1 Sunday October 25(D)

We depart for beautiful Lancaster, PA. Comfort stops, and a lunch stop will be made. Our 4 nights' accommodations are at the beautiful Amish View Inn, where you can look out your window to the pristine Amish Farms.

Day 2 Monday October 26 (B,D)

Travel through rolling fields and iconic landmarks as you hear powerful stories of courage, sacrifice, and strategy that shaped our nation's history. The afternoon brings creativity and inspiration at Elva's Barnyard Art Studio, featuring an engaging chalk talk that blends art, storytelling, and faith. A sweet stop at Wilbur Chocolates adds the perfect treat before we cap off the day at the Dutch Apple Dinner Theatre, enjoying a delicious meal and the hit production 'Beautiful: The Carole King Story'—a joyful finale filled with music, memories, and meaning.

Day 5 Thursday October 29 (B)
