Suggested Itinerary

Day 1 - October 13th - Depart for Logan Airport. Overnight flight to Dublin.

Day 2 - October 14th - Upon arrival at Dublin Airport, meet your Tour Guide and begin a sightseeing tour of Ireland's vibrant capital. Highlights include St. Patrick's Cathedral, Phoenix Park, O'Connell Street, Grafton Street, Trinity College, and the famous Guinness Storehouse, where you'll enjoy a guided tour and a pint with panoramic city views. Later, check into the Camden Court Hotel before joining your fellow travelers for a welcome dinner. Overnight: Camden Court Hotel, Dublin.

Day 3 - October 15th - Depart Dublin this morning for County Kildare, where you'll tour the renowned Irish National Stud Farm and its beautiful Japanese Gardens. Continue to Cashel for a guided visit of the iconic Rock of Cashel, one of Ireland's most important historic sites. Later, arrive in the charming harbor town of Kinsale, known as Ireland's gourmet capital, and check into the Trident Hotel. Enjoy dinner overlooking Kinsale Harbour at the hotel's Pier One Restaurant. Overnight: Trident Hotel, Kinsale.

Day 4 - October 16th - Travel to Blarney this morning to visit the famous Blarney Castle and Gardens, where you'll have the opportunity to kiss the legendary Blarney Stone. Enjoy free time at the Blarney Woollen Mills before continuing to Cork City for time to explore downtown Cork. Return to Kinsale for a relaxing afternoon to explore the charming harbor, shops, and marina at your leisure. Overnight: Trident Hotel, Kinsale.

Day 5 - October 17th - Depart Kinsale and travel along Ireland's scenic southern coast to Mizen Head, the country's southernmost point, where you'll visit the award-winning Maritime Museum and Lighthouse. Continue through picturesque coastal villages to the charming town of Kenmare before enjoying a scenic stretch of the famous Ring of Kerry en route to Killarney. Check into the Killarney Plaza Hotel for a two-night stay and enjoy dinner at the hotel. Overnight: Killarney Plaza Hotel, Killarney.

Day 6 - October 18th - Today, discover the breathtaking scenery of the Dingle Peninsula, one of Ireland's most spectacular coastal regions. Visit the Brian de Staic jewelry studio in Dingle before touring scenic Sleah Head, where you'll see ancient beehive huts, dramatic Atlantic views, the Blasket Islands, and famous filming locations, including Ryan's Daughter and Star Wars: The Last Jedi. Enjoy free time for lunch in Dingle before returning to Killarney. Overnight: Killarney Plaza Hotel, Killarney.

Day 7 - October 19th - Depart Killarney this morning and travel to Tralee before crossing the Shannon Estuary by ferry to County Clare. Visit the spectacular Cliffs of Moher, towering 600 feet above the Atlantic Ocean, then journey through the unique limestone landscape of the Burren. Continue along scenic Galway Bay to Galway City, where you'll check into the Maldron Hotel and enjoy dinner. Overnight: Maldron Hotel, Galway.

Day 8 - October 20th - Depart Galway and travel through the scenic Connemara region to Cong, famous as the filming location for The Quiet Man. Continue past Knock Shrine before stopping in Drumcliffe to visit the grave of renowned poet W.B. Yeats. Later, tour the famous Belleek Pottery Studio, Ireland's oldest pottery, before arriving in Donegal for a two-night stay. Enjoy dinner at the Mill Park Hotel. Overnight: Mill Park Hotel, Donegal.



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Day 9 - October 21st - Enjoy a scenic tour of County Donegal, including a stop in Ardara for an Irish coffee and shopping at Triona Design. Continue through the Blue Stack Mountains to Leo's Tavern, the family home of singer Enya, before returning through the picturesque Finn Valley to Donegal. Overnight: Mill Park Hotel.

Day 10 - October 22nd - Travel to Derry for a panoramic tour of its historic walled city, including a view of the modern Peace Bridge. Continue to the spectacular Giant's Causeway, a UNESCO World Heritage Site famed for its unique basalt columns, before enjoying the scenic Antrim Coast Road with views of Scotland. Arrive in Belfast and check into the Europa Hotel for an overnight stay. Overnight: Europa Hotel, Belfast.

Day 11 - October 23rd - Enjoy a guided tour of Belfast, featuring highlights such as City Hall, the Grand Opera House, the famous political murals, and Titanic Belfast, the award-winning museum celebrating the city's shipbuilding heritage. This afternoon, travel south to County Meath for a farewell dinner and overnight stay at the City North Hotel.

Day 12 - October 24th - After breakfast you will travel to Dublin Airport (30 minutes) for your flight home with fond memories and newly acquired accents and many stories to relate to friends and family.
