Itinerary

Day 1 Sunday

We depart for beautiful Lancaster, PA. Comfort stops, and a lunch stop will be made. Our 4 nights' accommodations are at the Amish View Inn.

Day 2 Monday

Start your day off with a relaxing train ride through Lancasters farmlands on the Strasburg Railroad. This afternoon you'll have a chance to enjoy our furry friends at Eastland Alpacas. Here at this family farm, you'll have the opportunity to learn about these multi-use animals. Our next stop will be Wilbur Chocolates. Since 1894 the famous Wilbur Buds have been favorites for chocolate lovers. Next, your senses will be engaged through music and storytelling with a former Old Order Mennonite during 'chalk talk'. Watch as her story is illustrated in front of our eyes. Tonight, we will have an evening with an Amish family. We are their guests for dinner at their home.

Day 3 Tuesday

This morning we'll be joined by a step on guide who will tour us through Lancaster's countryside with stops at local Amish bakeries, woodworking shops and quilt shops. After lunch, visit the Amish Farm and House. We'll start our visit with a guided house tour, learning all about the traditions, customs, and life today of the Amish. After this, visit the 15-acre farm at your leisure with an illustrated map. Among the attractions are an Amish one-room schoolhouse, wood carving, a covered bridge, historic barns and outbuildings, farm animals, a scooter trail, a wonderful gift shop and more. This recreated Village will give you an up-close and personal view of a typical Amish Farm. Tonight, you're in for a treat for dinner and a show at the Bird and Hand Stage.

Day 4 Wednesday

After your included breakfast we will depart for Kitchen Kettle Village. Here, we have arranged for a buggy ride for you. Relax, as you listen to the horses' hooves on this narrated ride by Amish homes and farms. While at the village you won't want to miss the famous Jam and Jellies shop!
