Suggested Itinerary

Day 1 (D)- Today we will travel through upstate NY on our way to Erie, PA. Dinner will be included at a local restaurant. Overnight accommodations at a Springhill Suites.

Day 2 (B,D) - After your included breakfast we will travel to Frankenmuth. This beautiful Bavarian town is home to Bronner's 'the world's largest Christmas store'. You'll have time on your own to explore this quaint little town. Overnight accommodations at Soaring Eagle Resort and Casino.

Day 3 (B,L) - We depart after breakfast and head north to Lake Huron and Mackinac Island (pronounced Mackinaw). You'll be an islander for the next 2 nights. Step back in time on this island where horses and bicycles are the only forms of transportation. Our stay will include the Grand Buffet at the Grand Hotel, a historic carriage ride of the Island and plenty of time on your own to explore. Overnight accommodations at The Murray Hotel, in the heart of downtown.

Day 4 (B) - Rent a bicycle, rent a horse and carriage, take a walk, shop, explore the Fort, visit the butterfly house or just relax...you're on island time. The day is yours to choose how you spend it.

Day 5 (B,L,D) - This morning we say goodbye to Mackinac Island. The ferry will take us back to the mainland where we board our coach for some more adventures. It's off to the Motor City where we'll visit the original Ford Plant and see where the first 12,000 Model T's came off the line. Two nights stay at a Marriott.

Day 6 (B) - After your included breakfast we depart for the Ford Museum of Innovation and Greenfield Village. Henry Ford could be considered the first American Picker. You'll be in awe at the extensive collection of Americana all in one place. At Greenfield Village you can ride in a Model T, take a carriage ride, speak with Thomas Edison at his workshop the night before he showcased his newest invention, or hear from the Wright Brothers about their flying machine. This village is where history becomes present.

Day 7 (B,D) - Enjoy a relaxing ride to Niagara Falls, Canada. Have free time to enjoy the amazing views and possibly take a walk behind the falls. Tonight your accommodations are at Turning Stone Resort and casino.

Day 8 (B)- Enjoy a relaxing ride home. We will make comfort stops and a lunch stop along the way.

Notice: This tour requires the use of stairs, uneven surfaces, and the ability to get in and out of horse drawn carriages. **You WILL need a passport.**
