ITINERARY



Depart for Logan Airport. Overnight flight to Morocco.

> Day 2

Arrival in Marrakech, transfer to the hotel followed by some rest after the flight. In the evening we will have a get together dinner with our group.

W Day 3

Today we'll explore Marrakech, the "Red Pearl of Morocco," once the heart of a great empire. Wander through its bustling souks and narrow medina streets, filled with spices, silks, and souvenirs. Visit the vibrant Majorelle Gardens and Museum, once owned by Yves Saint Laurent. This evening, experience the lively UNESCOlisted Jemaa el Fna Square with its music, storytellers, snake charmers, and tempting local dishes.

- Day 4


After breakfast, we'll depart Marrakech and journey through the Atlas Mountains, passing lush valleys of almond and fig orchards before descending toward the Sahara. As we enter Morocco's Great South, we'll see red Kasbahs, golden dunes, and palm-filled oases home to nomadic Berbers and Tuaregs, the "blue people." Traveling through the Valley of Roses and the towns of Skura and Mgun, we can sample local rose water and oils before continuing to the Dades Gorge for an overnight stay overlooking a palm oasis.

Day 5

Today we'll enjoy a relaxing day exploring the stunning Dades and Todra canyons, where towering cliffs rise over 300 meters and narrow to just 10 meters apart. We'll stroll through the gorges, admiring their shifting colors and the lush palm oasis filled with date, almond, fig, and pomegranate trees. Our hotel, set along the river amid the greenery, offers beautiful terrace views of the gorge for a peaceful evening.

Day 6

Today we continue our journey south toward the Sahara Desert, passing palm oases and the fossil-rich towns of Tinjdad, Toureg, and Erfud. In Merzouga, we'll meet our guides and ride camels into the golden dunes of Erg Chebbi, ending at our luxury Berber camp at the foot of towering sands. Enjoy a sunset walk, a traditional Berber tagine dinner, and an evening of music and dancing under the stars. Overnight in the Sahara Desert.





We'll rise early to witness the breathtaking sunrise over the dunes of Erg Chebbi before returning by camel to a luxury hotel for breakfast and relaxation by the pool. Later, a 4x4 adventure takes us along the Paris-Dakar route to the village of Camellia, home to Gnawa musicians known for their rhythmic trance music. We'll enjoy mint tea with locals before spending a peaceful afternoon at our oasis hotel, relaxing with tea and sweets amid the calm of the desert.



- Day 8

Today we bid farewell to Merzouga and journey along the ancient caravan route through the Draa Valley, once a lifeline for traders between Marrakech and Timbuktu. Passing kasbah ruins, ochre mountains, and palm-filled oases, we'll arrive at our serene guesthouse nestled among date palms. Enjoy a peaceful sunset walk through the oasis, surrounded by the scents of dates and desert blooms



W Day 9

Leaving our oasis behind, we travel through Morocco's red hills to reach Ait Ben Haddou, a UNESCO-listed ksar famed for its earthen towers and winding alleys. Featured in films like Gladiator and Game of Thrones, the citadel glows gold in the afternoon light. We'll explore its narrow paths and climb for sweeping views before dinner and an overnight stay in nearby Ouarzazate, the "Hollywood of Morocco."



- Day 10

This morning we journey west, crossing the Atlas Mountains as the landscape shifts from red rock to green valleys and finally to the Atlantic coast. By afternoon, we reach Essaouira, Morocco's coastal gem, where sea breezes and ocean views invite relaxation. Enjoy a beach stroll or mint tea on the terrace as waves roll in.



Day 11

Spend the day exploring Essaouira, the peaceful coastal city once known as Mogador. Wander its blue-and-white streets, watch fishermen at work, and browse art studios and shops in the UNESCO-listed medina. Enjoy live Gnawa music, seaside cafés, and a sunset walk or camel ride along the golden beach.



Day 12

After breakfast, we depart for Marrakech Airport for your onward flight. As we leave behind kasbahs and dunes, you'll carry home the memory of starlit skies, mint tea shared with desert nomads, and the haunting beauty of Morocco — a land where time drifts slowly, like sand through the fi ngers of a dream.
